If any proxy other than the Chairman of the Meeting is preferred, strike out “the Chairman of the Meeting or” herein inserted and insert the name(s) and address(es) of the proxy/proxies desired in the space provided. **ANY ALTERATION MADE TO THIS PROXY FORM MUST BE INITIALED BY THE PERSON WHO SIGNS IT.**
4. **IMPORTANT: IF YOU WISH TO VOTE FOR ANY RESOLUTION, TICK “✓” THE APPROPRIATE BOX MARKED “FOR”, IF YOU WISH TO VOTE AGAINST ANY RESOLUTION, TICK “✓” THE APPROPRIATE BOX MARKED “AGAINST”.** Each share carries the right of one vote. On a poll taken at the Meeting, a shareholder (including his proxy/proxies) entitled to two or more votes need not cast all his votes in the same way. Failure to complete any or all the boxes will entitle your proxy to vote or abstain at his discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his discretion on any resolution properly put to the Meeting other than those referred to in the notice convening the Meeting.
5. Ordinary resolutions shall be passed by an affirmative vote of more than half of the Company’s total voting shares being held by the shareholders present at the Meeting (including proxies).
6. This proxy form must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing, or, in the case of a corporation, must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised. Only one of the joint holders needs to sign.
7. In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holder(s). For this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of shareholders in respect of the joint holding.
8. To be valid, this proxy form, together with any power of attorney (if any) or other authority (if any) which it is signed or a notarially certified copy thereof, must be deposited at the Company’s H share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong (for H shares) or the Company’s office at 5th Floor, Longfu Mansion, No. 95 Longfusi Road, Dongcheng District, Beijing, the People’s Republic of China (for domestic shares) not less than 24 hours before the time scheduled for the Meeting (i.e. not later than 28 May 2026 at 10:00 a.m. (Hong Kong time)) or any adjournment thereof.
9. Completion and delivery of the proxy form will not preclude you from attending and voting at the Meeting if you so wish.
10. The register of shareholders of the Company will be closed from Tuesday, 26 May 2026 to Friday, 29 May 2026 (both days inclusive), during which no transfer of the Company’s shares will be effected. The holders of shares whose names appear on the register of shareholders of the Company on Tuesday, 26 May 2026 will be entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting.
11. Voting for the ordinary resolutions set out in the notice of the Meeting will be taken by poll.
