POLL RESULTS OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 12 JUNE 2026

Reference is made to the circular (the “**Circular**”) of China Energy Storage Technology Development Limited (the “**Company**”) and the notice of the annual general meeting (the “**Notice**”) issued to the shareholders of the Company (the “**Shareholders**”) on 30 April 2026. Unless otherwise defined, capitalised terms used herein shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular and the Notice.

POLL RESULTS OF THE AGM

At the annual general meeting held on 12 June 2026 (the “**AGM**”), the proposed resolutions as set out in the Notice were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll. As at the date of the AGM, the total number of issued Shares was 224,289,185 which was the total number of shares (the “**Shares**”) entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the resolutions at the AGM. There were no Shares entitling any Shareholders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of the ordinary resolutions proposed at the AGM as set out in Rule 13.40 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Listing Rules**”). No Shareholders were required under the Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the ordinary resolutions proposed at the AGM. None of the Shareholders has stated their intention to vote against or to abstain from voting on the resolutions at the AGM.

The Company's Hong Kong branch share registrar, Tricor Investor Services Limited, was appointed as the scrutineer at the AGM for the purpose of vote-taking. The poll results in respect of the resolutions proposed at the AGM are as follows:
