In the case of a joint holding, this form of proxy may be signed by any joint holder, but if more than one joint holder is present at the AGM, whether in person or by proxy, that one of the joint holders whose name stands first on the register of members in respect of the relevant joint holding shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
6. The form of proxy must be signed by a shareholder of the Company, or his/her attorney duly authorised in writing, or if the shareholder is a corporation, either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney so authorised.

To be valid, this form of proxy together with any power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a certified copy of such power or authority must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Boardroom Share Registrars (HK) Limited, at 2103B, 21/F, 148 Electric Road, North Point, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time of the AGM or any adjourned meeting.
8. Any alteration made to this form should be initialled by the person who signs the form.
9. Completion and return of this proxy form will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the AGM or any adjournment thereof if you so wish and in such event, the instrument appointing the proxy shall be deemed to have been revoked.
