POLL RESULTS OF AGM

The Board is pleased to announce that the annual general meeting of the Company was held on May 20, 2026 (the “**AGM**”), all proposed resolutions set out in the AGM Notice were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll.

With respect to resolution numbered 6, when exercising the Repurchase Mandate, the Directors may, depending on market conditions and the Company’s capital management needs at the relevant time of the repurchase, resolve to cancel the shares repurchased following settlement of any such repurchase or hold them as Treasury Shares, subject to compliance with the Listing Rules, the eleventh amended and restated memorandum and articles of association of the Company and the laws of the Cayman Islands. Treasury Shares, if any and registered under the name of the Company, shall have no voting rights at the general meeting(s) of the Company.

In addition, in respect of any treasury shares of the Company so deposited with the Central Clearing and Settlement System (“CCASS”) pending the use of which for the share schemes of the Company, the Company shall implement the following interim measures:

- (i) procuring its broker not to give any instructions to Hong Kong Securities Clearing Company Limited to vote at general meetings for the Treasury Shares deposited with CCASS;
- (ii) in the case of distributions or declaration of dividends, withdrawing the Treasury Shares from CCASS, and either re-register them in the Company’s name as Treasury Shares or cancel them, in each case before the record date for the distributions or declaration of dividends; or
- (iii) taking any other appropriate measures to ensure that it will not exercise any Shareholders’ rights or receive any entitlements which would otherwise be suspended under relevant laws if such Shares were registered in the name of the Company as Treasury Shares.

As more than 50% of the votes were cast in favour of each of the above ordinary resolutions numbered 1 to 7 and more than 75% of the votes were cast in favour of the above special resolution numbered 8, all of the above ordinary resolutions and special resolution were duly passed as ordinary resolutions and special resolution of the Company.

GENERAL

As at the date of the AGM, the total number of issued Shares was 724,205,350 Shares. The trustee (who held 45,610,899 Shares under the 2019 Share Incentive Plan, the Post-IPO RSU Scheme and the Post-IPO Share Option Scheme in aggregate) was required to and had abstained from voting on the resolutions proposed at the AGM. There were (i) 7,744,000 treasury Shares held by the Company (including any treasury Shares held or deposited with CCASS), and (ii) 2,485,000 Shares repurchased by the Company which are pending cancellation and should be excluded from the total number of issued Shares for the purpose of the AGM. Accordingly, the total number of Shares entitling the holders to attend and vote for or against the resolutions at the AGM was 668,365,451. There were no Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of any of the resolutions proposed at the AGM as set out in Rule 13.40 of the Listing Rules. No Shareholder was required to abstain from voting at the AGM under the Listing Rules. No Shareholder had indicated in the AGM Circular that they intended to vote against or to abstain from voting on any resolutions proposed at the AGM.

Dr. Xu Yao-Chang, the executive Director and the Chairman of the Board of the Company, presided at the AGM. The executive Directors of the Company, Dr. Xu Yao-Chang, Dr. Yu Hongping and Dr. Ji Jing, and the independent non-executive Directors of the Company, Dr. Sun Piaoyang, Mr. Sun Hongbin and Ms. Chui Hoi Yam attended the AGM in person or by electronic means.

The Company’s branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, was appointed as the scrutineer at the AGM for the purpose of vote-taking.

The Board is pleased to announce that as a result of the passing of above special resolution numbered 8, the Articles has been amended with effect from May 20, 2026.
