References are made to the notice (the “**AGM Notice**”) of the annual general meeting (the “**AGM**”) and the circular (the “**Circular**”) of Zibuyu Group Limited (the “**Company**”) both dated 10 April 2026. Unless otherwise indicated, capitalised terms used herein have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular.

POLL RESULTS OF AGM

At the AGM held on Monday, 11 May 2026, pursuant to the Listing Rules requirements and the provisions of the Articles, a poll was demanded by the chairman of the AGM for voting on all the proposed resolutions (the “**Proposed Resolutions**”) at the AGM as set out in the AGM Notice. The AGM was chaired by Mr. Hua Bingru.

As at the date of the AGM, the total number of issued Shares was 500,000,000 Shares (excluding treasury shares, if any). The trustee of the share award scheme adopted by the Company on 15 September 2023 and funded by existing Shares only, which either directly or indirectly held a total of 10,727,000 Shares as at the opening of business on the date of the AGM, was required to abstain and had abstained from voting on the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM pursuant to Rule 17.05A of the Listing Rules. Henceforth, the total number of Shares entitling the holders to attend and vote for or against the Proposed Resolutions was 489,273,000 Shares. There were no restrictions on any Shareholders to cast votes on any of the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM. There were no Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of any of the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM as set out in Rule 13.40 of the Listing Rules. There were no treasury shares held by the Company (including any treasury shares held or deposited with CCASS) and as such, no holders of treasury shares were required to be excluded or abstain from voting on the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM. There were no

repurchased Shares, and therefore no Shares are pending cancellation which shall be excluded from the total number of issued Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote on the Proposed Resolutions at the AGM.

Save for above, no Shareholder was required under the Listing Rules to abstain from voting on the Proposed Resolutions. None of the Shareholders have indicated in the Circular that they intended to vote against or to abstain from voting on any Proposed Resolutions at the AGM. There were no Shares voted but excluded from calculating the poll results of the Proposed Resolutions.

The Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, was appointed as the scrutineer for the purpose of vote-taking at the AGM.
