The Rights Issue is conditional upon the fulfilment (or waiver (as applicable)) of the conditions set out under the paragraph headed “Conditions of the Rights Issue” in the letter from the Board in the Prospectus.

The Underwriting Agreement contains provisions granting the Underwriter the right in its absolute discretion to terminate the obligations of the Underwriter thereunder on the occurrence of certain events. Such events are set out in the section headed “Termination of the Underwriting Agreement” in the Prospectus. If the Underwriting Agreement is terminated by the Underwriter or does not become unconditional, the Rights Issue will not proceed.

The Consolidated Shares have been dealt in on an ex-rights basis from Friday, 28 August 2020.
