INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

Reference is made to the announcement of the Company dated 19 June 2015, the circular of the Company dated 30 June 2015 (the “**Circular**”) and the announcement of the Company dated 24 July 2015 in relation to the reduction of the issued share capital of the Company by reducing the par value of each issued Share from HK\$0.50 to HK\$0.25 (the “**Original Capital Reduction**”) and the sub-division of each authorised but unissued Share into two (2) unissued new shares with par value of HK\$0.25 each (the “**Original Sub-division**”).

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

The Original Capital Reduction and the Original Sub-division, among other things, were approved by the Shareholders by way of special resolution at the extraordinary general meeting of the Company on 24 July 2015. As at the Latest Practicable Date, the Original Capital Reduction and the Original Sub-division have not become effective.

The Board noted that the Shares have been trading below HK\$0.25 since 6 July 2015. Where there are joint holders of any shares, any one of such joint holders may vote at the Meeting, either in person or by proxy, in respect of such share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders be present at the Meeting, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company in respect of the joint holding.
7. Completion and delivery of an instrument appointing a proxy shall not preclude a member from attending and voting in person at the Meeting if the member so wish and in such event, the instrument appointing a proxy should be deemed to be revoked.
