CHARACTERISTICS OF GEM

PROPOSALS FOR RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS, GENERAL MANDATES TO ISSUE AND REPURCHASE SHARES AND NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with the AGM Notice and information regarding the resolutions to be proposed at the AGM relating to, *inter alias*, (i) the re-election of Directors; (ii) the granting of the Issue Mandate and the Extension Mandate; and (iii) the granting of the Repurchase Mandate.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Pursuant to article 108 of the M&A, at each annual general meeting, one-third of the Directors for the time being (or, if their number is not three or a multiple of three, the number nearest to but not less than one-third) shall retire from office by rotation, provided that each Director (including those appointed for a specific term) shall be subject to retirement by rotation at least once every three years at the annual general meeting. The retiring Directors shall be eligible for re-election.

Pursuant to article 112 of the M&A, the Board shall have power from time to time and at any time to appoint any person as a Director either to fill a casual vacancy or as an addition to the Board. Any Director so appointed shall hold office only until the first annual general meeting of the Company after his/her appointment, and shall then be eligible for re-election. Any Director appointed under this article shall not be taken into account in determining the Directors or the number of Directors who are to retire by rotation at an annual general meeting

Accordingly, Ms. Ma Liangping, Dr. Chen Xiaofeng, Ms. Liu Huijing and Mr. Pong Chun Yu shall retire from office and, being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election at the AGM.

The Nomination Committee considered and assessed the suitability of the above retiring Directors for re-election in accordance with the Company's nomination policy. The Nomination Committee also took into account the structure and size of the Board as well as the various diversity aspects set out in the Company's board diversity policy.

Accordingly, the Board accepted the Nomination Committee's nomination and recommended the above retiring Directors to stand for re-election at the AGM. The Board considers that the re-election of the above retiring Directors is in the best interest of Company and Shareholders as a whole.

Each of the above retiring Directors has abstained from voting on his/her own nomination when it was being considered.

Biographical details of the retiring Directors who are proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix I to this circular.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE SHARES AND THE EXTENSION OF ISSUE MANDATE

At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will be proposed for the Shareholders to consider and, if thought fit, to grant a general mandate to the Directors to exercise all powers of the Company to allot, issue and deal with the new Shares up to a maximum of 20% of the total number of Shares in issue at the date of passing of the relevant resolution. As at the Latest Practicable Date, based on 122,247,600 Shares in issue, the maximum number of Shares to be allotted and issued pursuant to the Issue Mandate will be 24,449,520. The Issue Mandate shall expire upon the earlier of (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required to be held under the Companies Act or the M&A; and (iii) the date upon which such authority given under the Issue Mandate is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders.

In addition, an ordinary resolution will also be proposed for the Shareholders to consider and, if thought fit, approve the extension of the Issue Mandate by adding to the aggregate number of Shares which may be allotted by the Directors pursuant to the Issue Mandate those Shares repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, if granted.

GENERAL MANDATE TO REPURCHASE SHARES

At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will be proposed for the Shareholders to consider and, if thought fit, to grant a general mandate to the Directors to exercise all powers of the Company to repurchase issued and fully paid shares in the capital of the Company. Under the Repurchase Mandate, the number of Shares that the Company may repurchase shall not exceed 10% of the total number of Shares in issue at the date of passing of the relevant resolution. The Repurchase Mandate allows the Company to make repurchases only during the period ending on the earlier of (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company's required to be held under the Company Laws or the M&A; and (iii) the date upon which such authority given under the Repurchase Mandate is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders.

An explanatory statement as required under the GEM Listing Rules, giving all the requisite information which is reasonably necessary to enable Shareholders to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate, is set out in Appendix II to this circular.

AGM AND PROXY ARRANGEMENT

The AGM Notice, which contains, inter alias, the resolutions to approve (i) the re-election of Directors; (ii) the granting of the Issue Mandate and the Extension Mandate; and (iii) the granting of the Repurchase Mandate are set out on pages 18 to 23 of this circular.

A form of proxy for use at the AGM is enclosed with this circular. Whether or not you intend to attend the AGM, you are requested to complete the accompanying form of proxy in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and return it to the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Boardroom Share Registrars (HK) Limited at Room 2103B, 21/F., 148 Electric Road, North Point, Hong Kong, as soon as possible and in any event not later than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM (i.e. at 11:00 a.m. on 8 October 2025) or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the AGM or any adjournment should you so wish.

Pursuant to rule 17.47(4) of the GEM Listing Rules, any vote of Shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll except where the chairman of the meeting, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands. An announcement will be made by the Company on the results of the poll and will be published after the AGM in the manner prescribed under rule 17.47(5) of the GEM Listing Rules.

CLOSURE OF REGISTER OF MEMBERS

The transfer books and register of members of the Company will be closed from 6 October 2025 to 10 October 2025, both dates inclusive, during which period no transfer of Shares can be registered. In order to qualify for attending and voting at the AGM, all Shares transfers accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Boardroom Share Registrars (HK) Limited, at Room 2103B, 21/F, 148 Electric Road, North Point, Hong Kong, not later than 4:30 p.m. on 3 October 2025. The record date for determining the eligibility of the Shareholders for attending and voting at the AGM is Friday, 10 October 2025.

RECOMMENDATION

The Board considers that, inter alias, the proposed (i) re-election of Directors; (ii) granting of the Issue Mandate and the Extension Mandate; and (iii) granting of the Repurchase Mandate are in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole. Accordingly, the Board recommends the Shareholders to vote in favour of all resolutions to be proposed at the AGM as set out in the AGM Notice.

The biographical details of the Directors proposed to be re-elected at the forthcoming AGM are set out as follows:

EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS

Ms. Ma Liangping, aged 52, has been appointed as an Executive Director and Chairman on 30 May 2025. Ms. Ma has extensive experience in corporate governance, financial management and brand building. Since 2008, Ms. Ma has worked at Sichuan Ruifeng Investment Management Group Co., Ltd. as a group director and financial controller, and is responsible for the overall management of the group's hotel and fast-moving consumer goods sales sectors. Prior to this, she worked as a branch business manager at China Construction Bank and as general manager of Chengdu Dandan Bailai Clothing Co., Ltd. Ms. Ma graduated from adult higher education in finance program of Southwestern University of Finance and Economics, China in 2005.

Ms. Ma entered into a service agreement with the Company for a term of 3 years on 30 May 2025 and is subject to retire by rotation and is eligible for re-election at the AGM in accordance with the M&A or any other applicable laws from time to time. She is entitled to receive a remuneration of HK\$30,000 per month, which has been fixed by the Board with reference to, including but not limited to, her duties, responsibilities, performance, prevailing market conditions and remuneration benchmark relevant to other directors of listed companies of similar size. For the year ended 31 May 2025, Ms. Ma has received remuneration in the aggregate sum of approximately HK\$645 (including salary, commission, housing, reimbursement, allowances and discretionary bonus).

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Ms. Ma was beneficially interested in 33,870,000 Shares through Keen Champ, within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO, representing approximately 27.71% of the issue share capital of the Company.

Ms. Liu Huijing, aged 42, has been appointed as an Executive Director on 3 April 2023 and is currently also serves as the CEO and a member of Nomination Committee. Ms. Liu has extensive experience in entertainment, brand promotion and business management. From 2006 to 2023, she worked at New Sparkle Roll International Group Limited (“**New Sparkle**”, a company listed on the main board of the Stock Exchange (stock code: 970)) and held various senior positions, including deputy general manager, investment manager and assistant to the group’s chairman of New Sparkle, where she was responsible for overseeing marketing and brand management of world-renowned high-end luxury brands represented by New Sparkle or associated with it in Shanghai, including Davidoff, Richard Mille, DeWitt, Parmigiani, Boucheron and Rolls-Royce, and the operation of the group’s film and television and media sections. Ms. Liu obtained a master’s degree in marketing from the University of Hertfordshire in the United Kingdom in 2011.

Ms. Liu entered into a service agreement with the Company for a term of 3 years commencing since 3 April 2023 and is subject to retirement and re-election at the AGM in accordance with the M&A or any other applicable laws from time to time. She is entitled to receive a remuneration of HK\$70,000 per month, which has been fixed by the Board with reference to, including but not limited to, her duties, responsibilities, performance, prevailing market conditions and remuneration benchmark relevant to other directors of listed companies of similar size. For the year ended 31 May 2025, Ms. Liu has received remuneration in the aggregate sum of HK\$1,386,000 (including salary, commission, housing, reimbursement, allowances and discretionary bonus).

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Ms. Liu was beneficially interested in 4,265,250 Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO, representing approximately 3.49% of the issue share capital of the Company.

INEDs

Dr. Chen Xiaofeng, aged 35, has been appointed as an INED, the chairman of the Nomination Committee and a member of Audit Committee and Remuneration Committee on 22 November 2024. Dr. Chen obtained a bachelor's degree in laws from Shenzhen University, China; a master's degree in Laws majoring in international economic law, an executive master's degree in business administration (with distinction) and a doctoral degree of juridical science in law from City University of Hong Kong, and a master's degree of in public administration from Tsinghua University, China. Dr. Chen has been serving in both private and public sectors with extensive experience in areas such as public policy, law, strategic research, executive management, financial investment, corporate governance and business collaboration. He is a founder of Darelove Technology Limited, and currently appointed as chief scientist and legal advisor of Innovation and Entrepreneurship Center for Hong Kong and Macao Youth at Shenzhen North Railway Station (深圳北站港澳青年創新創業中心), and a director of Travelsky Mobile Technology Limited, etc.

Dr. Chen was appointed as executive director of Xinhua United Investment Co., Ltd. (formerly known as Huihuang Technology (Holdings) Co., Ltd. (stock code: 8159)) from February 2022 to December 2022.

Dr. Chen is a member of Chinese Association of Hong Kong & Macao Studies, a council member of Hong Kong Basic Law and Macao Basic Law Research Association of China Law Society, an expert mediator of China Council for the Promotion of International Trade Shenzhen Municipal Committee, a guest researcher of the Hong Kong and Macao Basic Law Research Center of Shenzhen University, off-campus tutor for Master of Laws of Shenzhen University, visiting professor of Nanning Normal University in Guangxi, and an expert of the Guangdong Provincial Law Society for building a Hong Kong and Macao legal talent pool in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (廣東省法學會粵港澳大灣區建設港澳法治人才庫). He is recognised by the government of Shenzhen Municipality as Overseas High-Caliber Personnel (Peacock Plan) of Shenzhen (深圳市海外高層次人才(孔雀人才)).

Dr. Chen was awarded Ten Outstanding New Hong Kong Youth Elites in December 2018, a member of the 14th National People's Congress Representative Election Meeting of the HKSAR approved by voting at the 36th meeting of the Standing Committee of the 13th National People's Congress in September 2022. and was awarded the Medal of Honor by the government of Hong Kong in July 2024.

For public services in Hong Kong, Dr. Chen is serving as a member of the 5th Hong Kong Election Committee (Fifth Sector) in August 2021. He is also a panel member of the Municipal Services Appeals Board under the office of Chief Secretary for Administration, the vice chairman of the Yuen Long (Tin Shui Wai South and Ping Ha) Area Committee, a member of Ad Hoc Committee on Primary Humanities Curriculum of Education Bureau, and a member of the Sustainable Fisheries Development Fund Advisory Committee, etc. Dr. Chen is one of the main founders of the Hong Kong KOL Project of the Hong Kong Association of Youth Commentators, the president of the Hong Kong Longhua Youth Association Limited and the founding chairman of the Hong Kong Association of Youth Development.

For public services in Mainland China, Dr. Chen serves as a consultant to the 13th All-China Youth Federation, to the 12th Standing Committee of the Hunan Provincial Youth Federation, and to the 13th and 14th Beijing Municipal Committee of CPPCC (北京市政協) on Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan, overseas Chinese and foreign friendship affairs.

Dr. Chen entered into an appointment letter with the Company for an initial term of three years commencing since 22 November 2024, unless being terminated in accordance with the respective terms in the appointment letter. He is subject to retirement and re-election at the AGM in accordance with the M&A or any other applicable laws from time to time. He is entitled to receive remuneration and emoluments in a total amount of HK\$120,000 as an INED per annum. His remuneration is determined by the Board with reference to his experience, qualifications, duties and responsibilities with the Company, and the prevailing market conditions. For the year ended 31 May 2025, Dr. Chen has received emoluments in the aggregate sum of HK\$63,000 (including salary, commission, housing, reimbursement, allowances and discretionary bonus).

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Dr. Chen does not hold any interest in the Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO.

Mr. Pong Chun Yu, aged 47, has been appointed as an INED, the chairman of the Audit Committee and Remuneration Committee and a member of the Nomination Committee on 22 January 2021. Mr. Pong is an associate member of The Hong Kong Institute of Directors and fellow member of Hong Kong Institute Certified of Public Accountants. Mr. Pong was the financial controller of Sunny Side Up (Never) Limited, an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Sun Entertainment Group Limited (stock code: 8082) (from December 2016 to November 2018). He was a financial manager of Television Broadcasts Limited (a company listed on main board of the Stock Exchange (stock code: 511)) (from April 2022 to September 2022). Mr. Pong graduated from the Hong Kong Baptist University in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration (Accounting). Mr. Pong currently holds 20,352 share options of the Company.

Mr. Pong entered into an appointment letter with the Company for an initial term of three years commencing since 22 January 2021, unless being terminated in accordance with the respective terms in the appointment letter. He is subject to retirement and re-election at the AGM in accordance with the M&A or any other applicable laws from time to time. He is entitled to receive remuneration and emoluments in a total amount of HK\$180,000 as an INED per annum. His remuneration is determined by the Board with reference to his experience, qualifications, duties and responsibilities with the Company, and the prevailing market conditions. For the year ended 31 May 2025, Mr. Pong has received emoluments in the aggregate sum of HK\$180,000 (including salary, commission, housing, reimbursement, allowances and discretionary bonus).

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Pong was beneficially interested in 20,352 Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO, representing approximately 0.02% of the issue share capital of the Company.

Each of Ms. Ma Liangping, Ms. Liu Huijing, Dr. Chen Xiaofeng and Mr. Pong Chun Yu has confirmed that as at the Latest Practicable Date, save as disclosed above, he/she (i) does not hold any directorship in other publicly listed companies, whether in Hong Kong or other jurisdiction in the last three years, and other major appointments and professional qualifications; (ii) does not have any relationship with any other Directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders (as defined in the GEM Listing Rules) of the Company; (iii) does not hold any other position in the Company or any of its subsidiaries; (iv) does not have any interest in the Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO.

Save as disclosed above, there are no other matters relating to the re-election of the abovenamed retiring Directors that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders and there is no information which is required to be disclosed pursuant to the requirements of rules 17.50(2)(h) to 17.50(2)(v) of the GEM Listing Rules.

APPENDIX II EXPLANATORY STATEMENT OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

This appendix serves as an explanatory statement as required by the GEM Listing Rules to provide the Shareholders with requisite information necessary for them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the resolution to be proposed at the AGM in relation to the granting of the Repurchase Mandate.

SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the total number of shares in issue was 122,247,600 Shares. Subject to the passing of the resolution for approving the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares will be allotted and issued or repurchased prior to the AGM, the Company will be allowed to repurchase a maximum of 12,224,760 Shares under Repurchase Mandate, representing 10% of the issued Shares at the date of passing of such resolution.

REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

The Directors believe that granting of the Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per share and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

IMPACT ON THE COMPANY'S WORKING CAPITAL AND GEARING POSITION

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital and/or gearing position of the Company as compared with the position disclosed in the audited consolidated financial statements for the financial year ended 31 May 2025 in the event that the Repurchase Mandate were to be exercised in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements or the gearing position of the Company which, in the opinion of the Directors, are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

APPENDIX II EXPLANATORY STATEMENT OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company will only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with the M&A, the Companies Act and any other applicable laws, as the case may be. Under the Companies Act, any repurchases by the Company may be made either (1) out of profits of the Company; (2) out of the share premium account of the Company; (3) out of the proceeds of a fresh issue of Shares made for the purpose of the repurchase; or (4) out of capital, if so authorised by the M&A and subject to the provisions of the Companies Act. In the case of any premium payable over the par value of the Shares to be repurchased on the repurchase, such premium must be provided out of either or both of the profits of the Company or the share premium account of the Company, or out of capital, if so authorised by the M&A and subject to the provisions of the Companies Act. In accordance with the Companies Act, the Shares so repurchased would remain part of the authorised but unissued share capital of the Company.

EFFECT OF THE EXERCISING THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Upon the exercise of the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interests in the voting rights of the Company increases, and such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. Accordingly, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert (as defined in the Takeovers Code) could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and, depending on the level of increase of the Shareholders' interests, may become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the substantial Shareholders: (1) Mr. Wang Ning was interested in an aggregate of 17,401,761 Shares, representing approximately 14.23% of the issued Shares carrying voting rights; (2) Mr. Yuan Lin, Zhongcai Investment and Zhongcai Industry (together the **"Yuan's Concert Group"**), who are presumed to be acting in concert under the Takeovers Code, were interested in an aggregate of 23,918,250 Shares (of which Mr. Yuan (i) personally holds 11,643,250 Shares; (ii) is deemed to have interest in 200,000 Shares held by his spouse and (iii) is deemed to have interest in 12,075,000 Shares held by his indirectly controlled company, Zhongcai Investment which directly and wholly owned by Zhongcai Industry, which is directly held as to 90% by Mr. Yuan), representing approximately 19.56% of the issued Shares carrying voting rights; and (3) Ms. Ma Liangping and Keen Champ (together the **"Ma's Concert Group"**), who are presumed to be acting in concert under the Takeovers Code, were interested in an aggregate of 33,870,000 Shares (of which Ms. Ma is deemed to have interest in 33,870,000 Shares held by her directly wholly owned company, Keen Champ), representing approximately 27.71% of the issued Shares carrying voting rights. In the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full, assuming that the present shareholdings and capital structure of the Company remains the same, the shareholding percentages of (1) Mr. Wang and (2) Yuan's Concert Group would increase to approximately 15.82% and 21.74%, respectively, and such increase would not trigger a mandatory offer obligation under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code. However, the shareholding percentage of (3) Ma's Concert Group would increase to approximately 30.78%, which would trigger a mandatory offer obligation under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code. The Directors do not intend to exercise the power to repurchase Shares to an extent which would render any Shareholder or group of Shareholders obliged to make a mandatory offer under the Takeovers Code. Saved as disclosed, the Directors are not aware of any consequences which would arise under the Takeovers Code as a result of the exercise of the Repurchase Mandate.

APPENDIX II EXPLANATORY STATEMENT OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Currently, the Directors also have no intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate in full to such extent that will trigger any potential consequences under the Takeovers Codes or result in the number of Shares held by the public falling below the prescribed requirement.
