Voting and attendance at the General Meeting

1. To ensure your votes are cast in accordance with your wishes, you are strongly encouraged to vote on all resolutions in advance of the GM by completing an online proxy appointment form appointing the Chairman of the meeting as your proxy given that the UK Government's current restrictions mean that neither you nor any other person you might appoint as your proxy will be able to attend the meeting in person.

Shareholders are encouraged to submit their voting instructions and Form of Proxy as soon as possible, even if they might intend to attend the GM in person should the Coronavirus situation and the UK Government's guidance change so as to permit this.

Vote online

2. Shareholders are strongly encouraged to register the appointment of their proxy electronically through Equiniti's website at www.sharevote.co.uk where full instructions on the procedure are given. The Voting ID, Task ID and Shareholder Reference Number printed on the Form of Proxy will be required in order to use the electronic proxy appointment system. Alternatively, shareholders who have already registered with Equiniti's online portfolio service, Shareview, can appoint their proxy electronically by logging on to their portfolio at www.shareview.co.uk using their usual user ID and password, then clicking on 'View' on the 'My Investments' page, leading to the link to vote. The on-screen instructions give details on how to complete the proxy appointment process. A proxy appointment made electronically will not be valid if sent to any address other than those provided or if received after 10.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 20 May 2020. Proxies may also be appointed through CREST in accordance with note 9 below.

Form of Proxy

3. Alternatively, this Form of Proxy may be used to appoint a proxy and, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is authenticated, or a certified copy of such authority, must be received at the Company's registrars, Equiniti, Aspect House, Spencer Road, Lancing, West Sussex BN99 6DA not later than 20 May 2020 at 10.00 a.m. being 48 hours before the earliest time appointed for the meeting or any adjournment thereof.

4. This Form of Proxy must be executed by the appointor or his/her attorney, duly authorised in writing or, if the appointor is a corporation, under its common seal or by the signature of a duly authorised attorney or officer or other person duly authorised on their behalf (and the signature on the appointment of proxy need not

be witnessed).

5. When two (or more) valid but differing appointments of proxy are received in respect of the same share(s) for use at the same meeting and in respect of the same matter, the one which is last validly received (regardless of its date or of the date of its execution or submission) shall be treated as replacing and revoking the other or others as regards the share(s). If the Company is unable to determine which appointment was last validly received, none of them shall be treated as valid in respect of the relevant share(s).

Multiple proxies

6. A member entitled to vote at the GM may appoint one or more persons (who need not be members) as their proxy or proxies to exercise all or any of their rights to vote at the GM, provided that each proxy is appointed to exercise the rights attaching to a different share or shares held by them. To appoint more than one proxy pursuant to a hard copy Form of Proxy, members should photocopy this form as a separate Form of Proxy must be completed for each proxy unless proxies are being appointed electronically in which case, please refer to note 2 above. Please indicate next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which you authorise them to act as your proxy. If left blank your proxy will be deemed to be authorised in respect of your full voting entitlement (or if this Form of Proxy has been issued in respect of a designated account for a member, the full voting entitlement for that designated account). Please also indicate by ticking the box provided if the proxy instruction is one of multiple instructions being given. All forms must be signed and, if returned by post, should be included in the same envelope.

Revoking your proxy

7. Members may change their proxy instructions by returning a new Form of Proxy using the methods set out above. Please contact the Company's registrars, Equiniti Limited at Aspect House, Spencer Road, Lancing, West Sussex BN99 6DA if another Form of Proxy is required. The deadline for receipt of proxy appointments (see above) also applies in relation to amended instructions. Any attempt to terminate or amend a proxy appointment received after the relevant deadline will be disregarded.

Joint shareholders

8. In the case of joint holders only the signature of one of the joint holders is required but, if more than one joint holder votes, the vote of the first named holder on the register of members shall be accepted to the exclusion of other vote(s) (if any) of joint holder(s).

Euroclear electronic proxy appointment service (CREST)

9. CREST members who wish to appoint a proxy or proxies through the CREST electronic proxy appointment service may do so for the GM to be held on Friday, 22 May 2020 and any adjournment(s) thereof by using the procedures described in the CREST Manual on the Euroclear website (www.euroclear.com). CREST personal members or other CREST sponsored members, and those CREST members who have appointed a voting service provider(s), should refer to their CREST sponsor or voting service provider(s), who will be able to take the appropriate action on their behalf.

10. In order for a proxy appointment or instruction made using the CREST service to be valid, the appropriate CREST message (a 'CREST Proxy Instruction') must be properly authenticated in accordance with Euroclear UK & Ireland Limited's specifications and must contain the information required for such instructions, as described in the CREST Manual. The message regardless of whether it constitutes the appointment of a proxy or an amendment to the instruction given to a previously appointed proxy must, in order to be valid, be transmitted so as to be received by the Company's agent (ID RA19) by 10.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 20 May 2020 (the latest time for receipt of proxy appointments specified in the Notice). For this purpose, the time of receipt will be taken to be the time (as determined by the timestamp applied to the message by the CREST Applications Host) from which the issuer's agent is able to retrieve the message by enquiry to CREST in the manner prescribed by CREST. After this time any change of instructions to proxies appointed through CREST should be communicated to the appointee through other means.

11. The Company may treat as invalid a CREST Proxy Instruction in the circumstances set out in Regulation 35(5)(a) of the Uncertificated Securities Regulations 2001.

Electronic communications

12. The Company takes all reasonable precautions to ensure no viruses are present in any electronic communication it sends out but the Company cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage arising from the opening or use of any email or attachments from the Company and recommends that members subject all messages to virus checking procedures prior to use. Please note that any electronic communication received by the Company that is found to contain any computer virus will not be accepted.

13. Members may not use any electronic address provided in this Form of Proxy to communicate with the Company for any purposes other than those expressly stated.
