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
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These notes are subject to the arrangements for participating at the 2025 Annual General Meeting, as explained in the Notice of the Meeting.

- You are entitled to appoint one or more persons of your choice, each a "proxy", to attend, speak and vote on your behalf at the AGM.
 - i. You can choose a proxy other than the Chair of the Meeting by deleting the words "the Chair of the Meeting" and writing in block capitals another proxy's name in the box provided. Such proxy need not be a member of the Company.
 - ii. If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy.
 - iii. If left blank your proxy will be deemed to be authorised in respect of your full voting entitlement (or if this Form of Proxy has been issued in respect of a designated account for a shareholder, the full voting entitlement for that designated account).
 - You must inform the Company's Registrar in writing of any termination of the authority of a proxy.
- 2. If you are unable to attend the Meeting but wish to vote on the resolutions you are strongly encouraged to appoint a proxy, with voting instructions, to ensure your vote is counted.
- 3. You may appoint more than one proxy provided that each proxy is appointed to exercise rights attaching to different shares. To appoint more than one proxy (an) additional proxy form(s) may be obtained by contacting the Company's Registrar, Equiniti on +44 (0)371 384 2859 (lines are open from 8.30 am to 5.30 pm Monday to Friday excluding public holidays in England and Wales) or you may photocopy this form. Please indicate in the box next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. Please also indicate by ticking the box provided if the proxy instruction is one of multiple instructions being given. All forms must be signed and returned together in the same envelope.
- 4. Pursuant to regulation 41 of the Uncertificated Securities Regulations 2001, entitlement to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting and the number of votes which may be cast thereat will be determined by reference to the register of members of the Company at 6.30 pm on the day which is two days before the day of the Annual General Meeting or adjourned Annual General Meeting or adjourned Annual General Meeting (excluding non-working days). Changes to entries on the register of members after that time shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend and vote at the Meeting.
- 5. To be valid, this form and the evidence of the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed, or a duly certified copy of such authority, must reach the Company's Registrar not later than 12 noon on Tuesday, 4 February 2025.
- 6. If you wish to submit your proxy appointment electronically, please visit www.shareview.co.uk. You will need to create an online portfolio using your Shareholder Reference Number (SRN), which is printed on this form in order to vote. Full instructions on how to complete the voting process are provided on the website. Electronic proxies must be lodged on the website no later than 12 noon on Tuesday, 4 February 2025.
- 7. Completion and return of the Form of Proxy, or appointing your proxy electronically, will not preclude you from attending and voting at the Meeting instead of your proxy, if you wish.
- 8. If you submit more than one valid proxy appointment, the appointment received last before the latest time for the receipt of proxies will take precedence.
- 9. CREST members may appoint a proxy or proxies electronically. In order to be valid, proxy appointments transmitted through CREST must be lodged with the issuer's agent (RA19) no later than 12 noon on Tuesday, 4 February 2025. Further details can be found in the notes appended to the Notice of the Meeting.
- 10. If you are an institutional investor you may be able to appoint a proxy electronically via the Proxymity platform, a process which has been agreed by the Company and approved by the Registrar. For further information regarding Proxymity, please go to www.proxymity.io. Your proxy must be lodged by 12 noon on Tuesday, 4 February 2025 in order to be considered valid. Before you can appoint a proxy via this process you must have agreed to Proxymity's associated terms and conditions. It is important that you read these carefully as you will be bound by them and they will govern the electronic appointment of your proxy.
- 11. Where the appointer is a corporation this Form of Proxy must be executed by the corporation under its common seal, or executed under the hand of an agent or officer, duly authorised in writing.
- 12. In the absence of any instruction, the proxy will exercise their discretion as to whether, and if so how, they vote. On any other business arising at the Meeting (including any motion to amend a resolution or adjourn the Meeting) the proxy will act at their discretion.
- 13. In the case of joint holders any one of them may sign, but if more than one holder votes, the vote of the one whose name appears first on the register of the members shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders. Names of all joint holders should be stated.
- 14. Any alterations made in the form should be initialled.
- 15. You may not use any electronic address provided in this form of proxy to communicate with the Company for any purposes other than those expressly stated.
- 16. The address above is how your address appears on the register of members. Lines are open from 8.30 am to 5.30 pm Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays in England and Wales).
