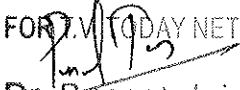

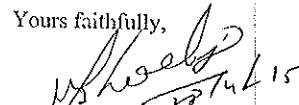

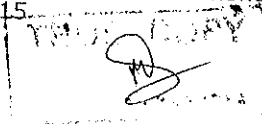

Mr. Chidambaram, the learned senior counsel for the petitioner
says that respondent no.1 herein, has not disposed of its application,
seeking permission to sell FM Radio business ('OYE 104.8 FM'). It
is stated that this application was filed on 16.02.2015.

Apart from the above, it is also the submission of Mr.

Chidambaram that the petitioner herein has also applied for migration from phase-II to phase III, and that this step had to be taken as the cut-off date fixed, by respondent no.1, for making, such an, application was 31.03.2015.

Mr. Narula, who appears on advance notice, on behalf of respondent no.1 says that the said respondent would have no difficulty in this court directing disposal of the petitioner's application dated 16.02.2015 .

It is further stated by Mr. Narula, on instructions of Mr. C.S.Kaushik, Director, FM, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting that the Non-Refundable One Time Migration Fee (in short NOTMF) will not be notified to the petitioner (which is relevant for the purposes of the application filed for migration), till such time the application dated 16.02.2015 is disposed of.

Mr. Chidambaram says that that the petitioner is satisfied with the statement made by learned counsel for respondent no.1 and therefore, the writ petition can be disposed of on this basis.

Needless to say, respondent no.1 will dispose of the application dated 16.02.2015 as expeditiously as possible though, no later than two weeks from today.

Since, I have not examined the other issues raised in the writ petition, all such issues are left open including the aspect pertaining to the maintainability of the writ petition, as raised by Mr. Narula.

The writ petition and the pending application are, accordingly, disposed of.
