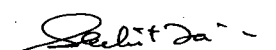

NOTES:

- The Company operates only in one business segment viz. "Steel" which is the reportable segment in accordance with the requirements of Accounting Standard (AS) -17 on Segment Reporting issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
- The rolling mill expansion was undergoing trial production during the corresponding quarter, hence the results may not be comparable.
- Exceptional Items comprises re-instatement gain/loss on External Commercial borrowings (ECB).
- Consequent to the enactment of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) and its applicability for accounting periods commencing from 1st April 2014 the Company has re-calculated the remaining useful life of fixed assets in accordance with provisions of Schedule II to the Act. In case of assets which have completed their useful life as per Schedule II to the Act, the carrying value (net of residual value) as at 1st April 2014 amounting to Rs. 0.82 crores (net of deferred tax) has been adjusted to Retained Earnings and in case of other assets the carrying value (net of residual value) is being depreciated over the re-calculated remaining useful life. The depreciation and amortisation expense charged for the quarter and nine months ended 31st Dec., 2014 would have been lower by Rs. 0.20 crores and 0.56 crores respectively, had the Company continued with the previously prescribed depreciation rates as per Schedule-XIV of Companies Act, 1956.
- The Company is eligible for incentives under the Mega Project Policy of the Punjab State Government for its expansion completed during last year. Though the plant has been commissioned but the benefits have not been considered in the above results as the same is pending for sanction by appropriate authority.
- Figures for previous periods have been recast/regrouped, wherever necessary to make them comparable.
- The Board of Directors has approved the above results in its meeting held on 31st January 2015 which have been reviewed by statutory auditors as per clause 41 of Listing Agreement.

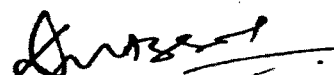

LIMITED REVIEW REPORT

The Board of Directors,
Vardhman Special Steels Limited,
Ludhiana.

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of Vardhman Special Steel Limited for the quarter ended 31st December, 2014 (the "Statement") being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement with Stock Exchange, except for the disclosures regarding 'Public Shareholding' and 'Promoter and Promoter Group Shareholding', which have been traced from disclosures made by the management and have not been audited by us. The Statement of Quarterly financial results has been prepared from interim financial statements which are the responsibility of the company's management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.
2. We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity, issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
3. Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles laid down in Accounting Standard AS-25 "Interim Financial Reporting" notified Pursuant to the Companies (Accounting Standards) Rules, 2006 (as amended) which continues to apply as per Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules 2014 and other recognized accounting practices and policies generally accepted in India has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in the terms of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement with the stock exchanges including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
