CG wins INR 119 crore order from NTPC, India's largest generation utility

- **To build the largest rating GSU transformer in India for NTPC**
- **To supply Generator Step-up Transformers for India's largest 800 MW Power Plant**
- **To partner NTPC in addition of generation capacity in the country**

Mumbai, February 16th, 2015: Avantha Group Company CG has been awarded with a prestigious contract by **National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC)**, the largest generation utility in India, for the design, manufacturing and supply of Generator Step-Up Transformers for its largest capacity, 800 MW super-critical thermal power plant at Darlipali in Odisha. The order comprises 315 MVA 765kV single phase Generator Step-Up (GSU) Transformers, 85 MVA 765 kV Tie Transformers and 80 MVAR Shunt Reactors. The project is scheduled to be completed in thirty-two months.
