## Cong opposes BMC plan to appoint single city planning authority

THE PROPOSAL to appoint the BMC as the single planning authority for the entire city has sparked a political fight with the Congress opposing the move.

On Wednesday, municipal commissioner IS Chahal presented a budget estimate of Rs 39,038.83 crore for the 2021-22 year. Citing revenue losses and to achieve speedy development, the Shiv Sena-led civic body has requested the state government to allow the BMC's appointment as the single planning authority.

A day after Mumbai Congress President Bhaji Jagtap held a press conference in the BMC headquarters and said the Congress will not support the idea. "Like the BMC, other agencies like the MMRDA, MHADA, MIDC have also made great contributions in the development of the city. If any organisation is not doing its work properly then it can be improved but giving all powers of development to the BMC is not right," he said.

At present, there are several other agencies like the Slum Rehabilitation Authority (SRA), Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA), Mumbai Port Trust (MPT) and the Maharashtra Housing and Area Development Authority (MHADA) that make their own development plans for the area which they own.

Although the Congress has an alliance with the Shiv Sena in the state government, the city president has clarified that the Congress will contest solo on all 227 electoral seats in the BMC election. In the past few months, the Congress has been aggressively targeting the Sena in the BMC. The BJP has taken a balanced stand on appointing the BMC as the single planning authority. BJP leader Ashish Shelar said although the BJP wants the BMC to be appointed as the single planning authority, but the civic body's proposal lacks proper study on how would it be implemented.

## Sushant death case: Another in NCB net

THE NARCOYTICS CONTROL Bureau (NCB) on Thursday arrested Jagtap Singh Anand in Sushant Singh Rajput death case, taking the total number of persons arrested in the case to 31. Anand is the brother of Karanjeet, another accused who was earlier arrested by the NCB.

"Anand accepted payments on Karanjeet's behalf. He has been charged for drug financing," said an NCB official.

The NCB is in the process of taking British national Karan Sajani and Rahila Furniturewala into custody. The duo was earlier arrested in a probe involving the seizure of marijuana. The NCB official added that the probe revealed that Anuj Keswani, also arrested in the case, is linked to Rahila.

## Security guard held for sexual assault of two minor girls

A 50-year-old man was arrested from Amboli last month for allegedly sexually assaulting two minor girls at a high-rise building in Andheri, where he worked as a security guard.

The police said the incident took place on January 25, when the two girls – aged 11 and 12 years – were playing in the building premises.

"We have learnt that the accused has been planning this for a while. He would keep an eye on the movement of the children while they played," said an officer of Amboli police.

"The parents then approached the police and filed a complaint," said the officer. A case was registered on

January 27 under sections 354 (outraging the modesty of the woman) and 506 (criminal intimidation) of Indian Penal Code and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act.

## BMC stresses long-term solution for floods in city

AHEAD OF the civic body polls, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) has set its focus on tackling flood issues in the city. The civic body is in the process of appointing international consultants to address city's flooding problems on a long-term basis.

In the last few years, Mumbai has seen severe waterlogging in many areas that led to criticism against the Shiv Sena, which has been ruling the civic body for over two decades. The BMC polls are to be held in early 2022.

On Wednesday, presenting the budget for 2021-22, Municipal Commissioner I S Chahal said the consultant will be appointed by April 2021.

After the success of mini pumping stations at Kalamnagar, Bandra east, BMC will now set up four more such stations across the city. Kalamnagar, which used to get flooded every monsoon, did not see waterlogging last year due to the flood gates and dewatering pumps at outfalls.

The BMC has proposed mini pumping stations with gated pumps at J K Chemical Nalla in Wadala, Kharu Creek Nalla, ONGC in Bandra east and Mallet Bunder in Mazgaon. These pumping stations will not require any mangrove cutting and not much space is needed for their construction, said sources.

With the help of the pumping stations, flood gates are installed in creeks to stop seawater entering the drains during high tide. With the pumping stations, the rainwater can be pumped out into the sea. At Kalamnagar, BMC has installed 11 gates and deployed 18 dewatering pumps.

According to the BMC, there are 386 chronic flooding spots in Mumbai, of which 171 have already been tackled. This year, the corporation has set a target of eliminating 120 flooding spots before the onset of monsoon.

"Work on 51 spots will be completed in the near future. There are 44 spots that fall under other au-

thorities and private owners and adequate coordination is being undertaken to prevent flooding," the BMC said.

"BMC has spent Rs 1,391 crore to tackle the flooding areas and in current year there are about 54 tenders finalised amounting to Rs 535 crore and work will start on war footing by February 2021," Chahal said in his budget speech. He added that tenders for Mogra pumping stations will be floated and a contract awarded by May. Another pumping station at Mahul has been facing land dispute as the location finalised for it belongs to the central government. BMC has also taken up widening of several other nullahs.

Earlier, Tourism Minister Aditya Thackeray had held meetings with civic officials and asked them to find out long-term solutions for flooding issues.

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
