Sub: Gayatri's Subsidiary M/s. Thermal Powertech Corporation India Ltd secures 20 Year -Fuel Supply Agreement for its Power Plant in Nellore District of Andhra Pradesh.

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GAYATRI PROJECTS LIMITED is pleased to announce that its subsidiary TPCIL (Thermal Powertech Corporation India Ltd.) has inks FSA (Fuel Supply Agreement) with MCL(Mahanadi Coal Fields Ltd.), a subsidiary of Coal India Limited for a period of 20 years.

TPCIL is in the process of setting up a 1,320 MW coal-fired generation plant with 2 units of 660MW each, in the Nellore district of Andhra Pradesh, located near the coast of Krishnapatnam. The plant has been designed to run on 70% domestic coal and 30% imported coal. The imported coal requirement will be met through TPCIL's coal supply agreement with PT Bayan Resources, which was secured in February 2012.

Under the FSA signed for Annual Contracted Capacity of 2.13 MTPA .MCL would be supplying coal to TPCIL's plant for a period of 20 years starting from the operationalization of the plant which is expected in FY 2014-15.

This development is an important milestone for TPCIL in meeting its coal requirement. Fuel being one of the most critical elements in the power supply chain, this agreement provides an assured quantity of coal supply for TPCIL for the next 20 years, enabling TPCIL to supply power to the lakhs of consumers in Andhra Pradesh and other parts of the country.

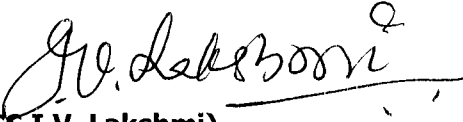


Pleased with the development, Managing Director of Gayatri Projects Ltd. Mr T.V Sandeep Reddy commented, "
