Tear gas, lathi-charge..

Many insisted they would not leave until the government accepted their demands.

The agitation is being spearheaded by the JPSC-JSSC Reforms Manch, which said it had deployed around 500 volunteers to prevent anti-social elements from joining the protest.

The protesters are demanding comprehensive reforms in the functioning of the Jharkhand Public Service Commission (JPSC) and the Jharkhand Staff Selection Commission (JSSC), cancellation of several disputed recruitment examinations, and an independent probe either by the CBI or by a panel of retired high court judges from outside the state into alleged irregularities. The clash intensified near the final security perimeter close to Jagannathpur Temple, around 200 metres from the Assembly. Police resorted to lathi-charge to clear the area after protesters allegedly became agitated following the firing of tear gas shells.

Shah ready for...

When the Opposition again protested over Shah's absence and demanded his statement on the violence during the students protest, Rijiju said, "We are ready to give a detailed response." However, he challenged the Opposition to stay put during Shah's response and not to run away. Grah mantri ji kay jawab kay samay, darna nahin hai, bhagna nahin hai, pooraa sunna padega (During the Home Minister's reply, do not be afraid, do not run, you will have to listen to him completely). Rijiju added that he had also stated publicly in the Business Advisory Committee that the government was fully prepared for a detailed discussion on the students' issue and is ready to give a comprehensive reply.

JNSU holds Umar Khalid

JNU cancelled the booking, saying "full facts" about the programme had not been disclosed.

The JNUSU termed the decision "arbitrary and authoritarian" and said the cancellation of the venue would not stop the discussion.

"However, let it be clear: cancelling a room does not cancel a conversation. No administrative order can suppress the right of students to think, question, and discuss," the students' union said in a statement.

The union subsequently announced that the discussion would be held outside the SSS-II building and called upon students, faculty and staff to participate.

9 dead as van swept...

During the incident, police officers and locals present at the site rescued the driver, Mukesh, and another individual, Hukum Singh.

Following the incident, the police force and the rescue team immediately launched a relief and rescue operation. During the sustained rescue efforts, the bodies of all nine missing persons were recovered.

Indore techie missing...

Backgrounder: Timeline and Investigation

When multiple phone calls went unanswered, his fiancée approached the Kadugodi police station.

Kadugodi authorities immediately coordinated with the Dobbspet police station to deploy special search teams. Investigators have also obtained a photograph taken by another tourist showing Upadhyaya at the hilltop around the time he lost contact. Specialised teams are continuing to navigate the challenging terrain and narrow ravines to locate the missing techie.

Kin Suspects Kidnaping as His Phone's Last Location Traced 22 km Away- Search teams recovered missing techie Advait's bag and sweater at Shivagange's restricted Shantala Point despite rain-hampered operations.

While police are investigating an accidental slip or suicide, his family suspects kidnapping because his phone's last location traced 22 kilometres away.

Bihar man waves, passenger train stops; Rlys begins probe

People waiting at a railway crossing in Bihar witnessed an unusual sight when a passenger train stopped in front of them, allowing a family of four to board before it reached the station. A video of the incident has gone viral on social media.

A person recording the incident could be heard saying, "Train ruk gayi. Ab Railway Ministry mein jaayegi yeh

video. Saamne prashasan ki gaadi bhi khadi hai (The train has stopped. Now this video will reach the Railway Ministry. There is also an administration vehicle parked right in front)." The incident occurred near Kumarbagh railway station in West Champaran, Bihar, on Aug 8. The video showed a family of four standing near the closed railway crossing as cars and other vehicles waited for the train to pass. One of

them was seen talking on the phone. The person recording the video speculated that he was speaking to an acquaintance who had helped get the train stopped there.

A few moments later, the Muzaffarpur-Narkatiaganj DEMU train arrived at the crossing. It slowed down before coming to a halt. The four people waiting near the crossing rushed towards a compartment and boarded the train. The video also showed

the gateman watching the incident. The X account @Sita-marhiJila, which posted the video, claimed that the man at the railway crossing was helping his family catch the train. It said his conversation on the phone made it appear that he could get the train stopped.

Railway Seva responded to the post, saying, "Related officials are being informed," and tagged the official account of the Samastipur Division of East Central Railway.



DONATIONS| SIT probe sought into alleged embezzlement at temple

SC may defer Ayodhya donations probe pleas

The Supreme Court on Monday agreed to consider deferring the hearing on a batch of pleas seeking a court-monitored SIT probe into alleged embezzlement of donations at the Ram temple in Ayodhya on a request by the counsel of the Uttar Pradesh government.

A bench comprising Chief Justice Surya Kant and Justices Joymalya Bagchi and V Mohana was apprised by a lawyer that Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, who has been appearing for the Uttar Pradesh government, has gone to the United Nations with a delegation to attend a function there.

The bench asked whether the cases are listed for hearing.

"Yes, item number 30-33...please take it up next



week," the lawyer said. The bench agreed to consider the request.

On July 27, the bench took note of setting up of a four-member SIT headed by IGP Kiran S to probe alleged embezzlement of donations at the Ram temple in Ayodhya. It had asked the Uttar Pradesh government to also include a forensic auditor in the probe team.

Observing that "remedial actions will have to be taken",

the bench had said steps will be taken to "ensure transparency".

The bench also directed the Special Investigation Team (SIT) to submit a status report in two weeks.

On July 20, the bench had asked the Uttar Pradesh government to apprise it about the possibility of setting up an SIT to probe the alleged embezzlement of donations.

It had asked the solicitor general to take instructions on

Champat Rai back in race for Ram Temple Trust post

Champat Rai, who stepped down as general secretary of the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust amid allegations linked to the alleged theft of temple offerings, is once again emerging as a strong contender for the post, with influential seers in Ayodhya openly backing his return.

Rai resigned as general secretary on June 26 after allegations surrounding the handling of donations and offerings at the Ram temple came under scrutiny. However, sources said the issue lost momentum within the Vishwa Hindu Parishad after its national meeting in

Delhi on July 22, where Rai was given a clean chit.

A day later, a meeting of prominent seers was held at Maniram Das Chhawani in Ayodhya, where several religious leaders declared Rai "innocent" and demanded that he be reinstated as the trust's general secretary. The move marked a significant shift in the atmosphere surrounding Rai, who had faced growing questions over the temple trust's functioning.

Since then, Rai has stepped up his outreach to the seer community. Sources said he has been visiting temples across Ayodhya, meeting mahants and seers and discussing the functioning of the Ram temple.

SC to hear Cauvery water plea on Aug 13

The Supreme Court on Monday agreed to hear on August 13 a plea of the Tamil Nadu government seeking directions to the Karnataka government for immediate release of the share of Cauvery water to it.

A bench comprising Chief Justice Surya Kant and justices Joymalya Bagchi and V Mohana took note of submissions made by the counsel representing the state government that in a rain-deficient year Tamil Nadu was not getting its due share of Cauvery water.

"We will list it for hearing on Thursday," the CJ said.

THE DOWNSIDE FOR NEW DELHI

Pakistan-Saudi Arabia-Turkiye pact

The recently signed Mecca Joint Defence Agreement between Saudi Arabia, Pakistan, and Türkiye has become the topic of much discussion in diplomatic circles. Some former diplomats say the pact constitutes a direct security threat for India, as it would mean Islamabad could now rely on both Riyadh and Ankara should a potential conflict erupt between India and Pakistan.

Former foreign secretary Kanwal Sibal holds this view. Sibal, who was also a former ambassador to Ankara, has voiced concern about the language used in the agreement, which includes a "NATO Article 5 type provision." Such a provision, Sibal believes, has serious implications for India, as New Delhi now has to deal with a "higher political and security profile of Pakistan in the region where we have major interests and where Pakistan was losing ground earlier."

The implications of this will be that Islamabad will now "feel more emboldened to pursue its combative diplomacy against India and could take risks on the terrorism front," where it could potentially rely on Saudi financing

and Türkiye providing weaponry.

Sibal contends that if this indeed proves to be the case, India's tensions with the Kingdom would rise and the quiet

diplomatic role that Riyadh has played between India and Pakistan as was witnessed in the aftermath of the April 2025 Pahalgalam attack would be over.

Rotten meat, fish found at Bengaluru luxury hotels

The Food safety officials, who have been on a drive against the unsafe food supply in Bengaluru restaurants have unearthed rotten meat, fish, vegetables in many high end hotels and restaurants, including five star hotels of Bengaluru city.

For the last three days, the Food Department officials have been on the drive and have destroyed large quantities of such

stale food stored in the cold storages, including fish and meat stored for over an year in the cold storages.

Food Department Commissioner Srinivas said that fish could be stored maximum for one month in the cold storages, but in a restaurant at UB City Mall, the fish was stored for more than one year, which is not fit for consumption. Even the chicken and mutton have expiry dates and have been stored for more than the expiry date. In some restaurants, it is

found that the restaurant staff change the manufacturing and expiry date stickers every week and keep it till it is used. "We have sent such suspected food for laboratory analysis and those food materials found to be stale have been destroyed," he said.

The raids started from Saturday evening, when the officials raided five star hotels like Lalit Ashok, Shangri La, Four Seasons, Vivanta Whitefield, Radisson Blue and Vivanta Yeshwantpur.
