TRIPLE MURDER IN PORBANDAR

Forest guard arrested after he tests negative for coronavirus

LAKHMAN ODEDRA, the forest guard booked for allegedly murdering fellow guard Hetal Solanki, her husband and casual labourer Nagajan Agath, was formally arrested by Porbandar police after he tested negative for Covid-19 on Thursday.

Police had started questioning Odedra on Tuesday evening after Hetal's father Vashram Rathod named him as a suspect in his complaint filed with Bagvadar police station in Porbandar. Police said that he was detained on Wednesday after it became evident that he had clubbed Hetal, her husband and the casual labourer to death after leading them into the Barda sanctuary under the pretext of raiding an ille-

gal brewery of illicit liquor inside the protected forest on Saturday afternoon. His samples were collected and sent for mandatory Covid-19 testing on Wednesday and police said the tests returned negative for the disease.

"He tested negative for Covid-19 and therefore, we formally arrested him on Thursday afternoon. During primary interrogation, he has confessed to have murdered the fellow forest guard, her husband and the casual labourer of the forest department," Smit Gohil, deputy superintendent of police (DySP) of Porbandar rural division told The Indian Express.

Gohil is the investigating officer of the case.

Gohil said that Odedra, a native of Porbandar district, had joined the Gujarat forest services as a guard in 2007 and that he had

come in contact with Hetal around two years ago when they were working together in the Barda Sanctuary. It was during this time that Odedra, who is a married man, developed soft feelings for Hetal, police said. However, after his wife Manju came to know about this, relationship between Manju and Odedra came under strain, police said.

Investigators said that Manju and Hetal also used to have verbal exchanges over the issue and during once such argument around 20 days ago, Hetal had allegedly abused and issued threats to Manju. After Manju complained about this to her husband, Odedra made a plan to eliminate Hetal, who was six months pregnant, and her husband Kirti, a teacher at a government primary school in Ratdi village of Porbandar.

2006 KALUPUR RAILWAY STATION BLAST CASE

ATS arrests Bengal man who 'helped' accused flee to Pak

THE GUJARAT Anti-Terrorist Squad (ATS) arrested a man from West Bengal who was allegedly involved in facilitating the escape of Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) operatives, who are accused in the 2006 Kalupur Railway Station bomb blast case, to Pakistan via Bangladesh border.

According to ATS officials, the accused, Abdul Razzaq Gazi, a resident of Soldana Bazar in Basirhat of North 24 Parganas in West Bengal, was arrested on August 18 by a team of Gujarat ATS for his role in the multiple bomb blasts which occurred on February 19, 2006 on platform 2 and 3 of Kalupur Railway Station in Ahmedabad. Over 10 people were injured when blasts had occurred inside the PCO booths installed at the platforms, said a statement from the Gujarat ATS.

According to ATS officials, Gazi had allegedly given shelter to Lashkar-e-Taiba operatives including 26/11 terror attack plotter Zabiuddin Ansari alias Abu Jundal and Zulfikar Faiyyaz Kagzi and facilitated their exit from India to Pakistan via the Bangladesh Border.

"The accused Abdul Razzaq Gazi was wanted for the past 14 years as he, after the 2006 Kalupur blast, had given shelter to Abu Jundal and Zulfikar Faiyyaz Kagzi who are key accused in the case. Abu Jundal is also responsible for the 26/11 attack and we suspect that Gazi in directives of Pakistan's ISI, had also facilitated the exit of the accused in Bangalore blast case. He is currently being interrogated to know that how many terrorists he had made the bor-

der cross in these years," said Imtiaz Shaikh, Superintendent of Police, Gujarat ATS.

After the February 19, 2006 bomb blasts, the Maharashtra ATS team had chased cars on Chandwad-Manmad Highway near Aurangabad on May 8, 2006 and arrested three terror suspects and seized 6 AK 47 rifles, 3,200 live cartridges, 43 kg of RDX and 50 hand grenades from Khultabad, Yeola and Malegaon area.

Jundal had then managed to give police the slip and drove to Malegaon and a few days later he escaped to Bangladesh from where he fled to Pakistan. Jundal's name had resurfaced as the man whose voice was intercepted in the

Karachi-based control room which had been giving instructions to the ten terrorists who carried out the 26/11 terror attack. In 2012, agencies had narrowed down his location to Saudi Arabia and had confirmed it through DNA samples taken from his family based in Beed. He was deported to India from Saudi Arabia in June 2012 and has been kept in Arthur Road jail since then.

According to Gujarat ATS officials, in the 2006 Kalupur Railway Station blast case, five accused — Mahmud Aamir Shakeel Ahmed Shaikh, Saiyyed Aaqib, Mahmud Ilyas Abdul Memon, Mahmud Aslam Kashmiri and Abu Jundal — have been arrested in the past.

Sharpshooter held for bid to attack BJP leader tests positive

A DAY after Gujarat Anti Terrorist Squad (ATS) apprehended an alleged sharpshooter of Chota Shakeel gang hired to allegedly assassinate senior BJP leader Gordhan Zafadia, the accused tested Covid-19 positive on Thursday.

The accused, Irfan alias Kalia Shaikh (24), a resident of Chembur in Mumbai was nabbed in a joint operation by Gujarat ATS and Ahmedabad Crime Branch from Hotel Vinus on Relief Road, near Lal Darwaza in old city Ahmedabad, around 2.30 am on Wednesday.

The accused had undergone compulsory Covid-19 test on Wednesday as per the regulations set by the Gujarat High Court. On Thursday morning, his results turned out to be positive. As per procedure, the accused will not be formally arrested and produced before the magistrate until he tests negative. An ATS official said, "Irfan Shaikh has been shifted to Sola Civil Hospital in an isolation ward under high security. On Tuesday itself, all personnel including officials involved in the operation underwent Covid-19 test and all of them turned out to be negative. So no personnel are currently under quarantine."
