NOTICE IS HEREBY given pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 and other applicable provisions if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with Rule 20 & 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 ("Rules") and Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations") Secretarial Standard issued by Institute of Company Secretaries of India on General Meetings ("SS-2"), (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force), General Circular No.14/2020 dated April 08, 2020 and General Circular No.17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, General Circular No. 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, General Circular No. 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020 and General Circular No. 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020 (the "General Circulars") issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") that Eris Lifesciences Limited ("the Company"), is seeking approval of the members by way of passing an Ordinary Resolution for reclassification of shareholders belonging to promoter group category to Public category, through postal ballot i.e., voting by electronic means.

Further, the MCA has, vide the aforementioned Circular dated 13th April 2020, permitted the dispatch of Postal Ballot Notices by email to the shareholders who have registered their email ids with the Company / RTA / Depository Participant / Depository and secure their votes through e-voting. In respect of those shareholders who have not registered their email ids, the Company has provided the mechanism in this notice to register their email ids and a public notice to that effect will be published.

The proposed Ordinary Resolution and Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Act setting out all material facts relating to the proposed resolution is annexed hereto for your consideration.

The Board of Directors of the Company has appointed Mr. Ravi Kapoor, Practicing Company Secretary (FCS No. 2587; COP No 2407), proprietor of M/s. Ravi Kapoor & Associates, Ahmedabad as Scrutinizer for conducting the E-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the Securities & Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and Section 108 and other applicable provisions of the Act read with the Rules, the Company is pleased to provide e-voting facility to enable the shareholders of the Company to cast their votes electronically, instead of Postal Ballot Form. The reasons for not enclosing the Postal Ballot form have already been explained in the foregoing paras. Members (whether holding shares in demat form or in physical form) are requested to cast their votes by E-voting. The Company has engaged the services of Link Intime India Private Limited ("RTA"), for the purpose of providing e-voting facility to all its Members.

The Company had received a letter dated 18th February, 2021 from the following persons falling under the category of “Promoters / Promoter Group” of the Company requesting to be re-classified from the category of “Promoters / Promoter Group” to “Public Category”:

Pursuant to Regulation 31A of Listing Regulations along with amendments thereto, the Board of Directors of the Company analysed and approve the request, and decided to place the same before the shareholders in a general meeting for approval and thereafter apply for stock exchanges' approval.

Background:

Mr. Himanshu Shah along with other Applicants are the part of our promoter and promoter group of the Company since inception. Mr. Himanshu Shah holds 8,08,348 shares representing 0.60% of the capital of the Company as on date of this notice. Other than Mr. Himanshu Shah none of the other applicant holds shares of the Company.

Request for reclassification:

Applicants vide their Request Letter sought re-classification from Promoter group to public group due to below reasons.

At the present stage, where Mr. Himanshu Shah, has had a fulfilling professional career in the Industry in general and as one of the promoters with Eris Lifesciences in particular, he now

aspires to dedicate the remaining part of his life to the pursuit of his other callings, interests and passions and also yearns to spend more time with the family, relatives, and social circles in general. He was relieved from the Board Position of Executive Director on 31st May, 2020 and further decided to bid adieu to the Eris team on 2nd February, 2021.

Further, the Applicants have confirmed that they:

- i) do not, together, hold more than 10% (ten percent) of the total voting rights in the Company;
- ii) do not exercise control over the affairs of the Company, directly or indirectly;
- iii) do not have any special rights with respect to the Company through formal or informal arrangements including through any shareholder agreements;
- iv) are not represented on the board of directors of the Company (including through nominee director);
- v) are not acting as a key managerial person in the Company;
- vi) are not 'wilful defaulters' as per the Reserve Bank of India Guidelines; and
- vii) are not fugitive economic offenders.

Further, the Applicants have confirmed that subsequent to their reclassification, they shall continue to comply with the provisions of Regulation 31A(4) of the Listing Regulations.

Impact of exit of Applicants from Eris Promoters and Promoter Group

Pursuant to said transaction the holding of Promoters and Promoter group will reduce to the extent of shareholding of Applicants.

The said requests for reclassification were considered and analysed by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on May 13, 2021 and approved, subject to members 'approval and stock exchanges' approval subsequently.

None of the Directors/KMP of the Company/their relatives are, in any way, concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the Ordinary Resolution set out at Item no. 1.

The Board recommends the resolution set forth in Item no. 1 for the approval of the Members.
