Felicitation at the Hands of Chief Minister Nitish Kumar

Munger becomes the first, fully electrified district in the state of Bihar.

Ashoka Buildcon Ltd. one of the largest highway developers in the country, through its Power Division, has successfully achieved early completion of electrifying the villages of Munger district.
