Court orders framing of charges against Jacqueline, Sukesh, others

A Delhi court on Saturday ordered framing of charges against actor Jacqueline Fernandez, alleged comedian Sukesh Chandrasekhar and 15 others in a Rs 200-crore money laundering case.

The court also ordered framing of charges against Chandrasekhar and 20 others for various offences, including under the stringent MCOCA provisions. In another case registered by the city police's special cell, in two separate orders, Additional Sessions Judge (ASJ) Prashant Sharma said that prima facie, there is sufficient material against the accused.

In the ED case, ASJ Sharma said that the accused persons "have to be charged with the offence for money laundering under Section 3 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), punishable under Section 4 of the PMLA, the ASJ said.

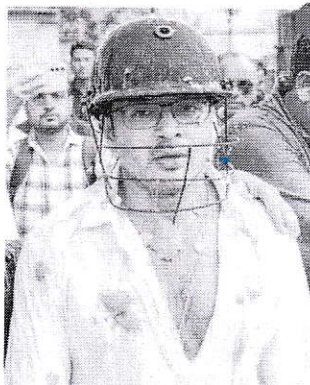
While Trinamool Congress (TMC) general secretary and MP Abhishek Banerjee went to visit the families of post-police violence victims in Sonarpur in South 24 Parganas on Saturday, local people gathered in the area, brandishing slogans of 'honor, chut' at Banerjee, and pelted him with stones, eggs and slippers.

The locals complained that they had lived in 'fear' during the TMC's rule and alleged that the former ruling TMC government had failed to provide basic

amenities to the people of the village.

Today Abhishek has come to see the families of the post-police violence victims. How many times did he visit the RG Kar victim's residence? It is mob fury that Abhishek has witnessed, said a local woman. Notably, Banerjee was made to wear a helmet to protect his head. However, his shirt was torn and his spectacles were broken.

Armed forces ready for Op Sindoor 2.0 if need arises: Dwivedi

The armed forces are fully prepared for 'Operation Sindoor 2.0' if the need arises. Chief of Army Staff General Upendra Dwivedi said on Saturday, asserting that all three services are enhancing synergy for modern multi-domain warfare that extends beyond land, air and sea.

Speaking at a press conference on the sidelines of the passing-out parade of the National Defence Academy (NDA) in Dehra Dun, General Dwivedi noted that while a temporary cessation of hostilities currently exists, all three services are preparing intensely for the next phase should it take place.

India launched Operation Sindoor, a military exercise to destroy terror infrastructure in Pakistan in May 2023, in response to the Peshawar terror attack, which claimed 26 lives in April.

As far as Operation Sindoor is concerned, Dwivedi, it is still continuing. There is a temporary cessation of hostilities. So the Indian Army and all the three services are preparing well for Operation Sindoor 2.0 if it takes place," he said.

He noted that future warfare will not be limited to land, air and sea, but will increasingly be influenced by emerging domains such as space, cyber and cognitive warfare.

Modern battleships have become highly transparent, General Dwivedi said, adding that military planners must remain cautious about deployments and force protection measures.

"What we have seen over a period of time is 24/7. The battlefield is so transparent that every movement is known to the other side. Therefore, we have to be very cautious, in terms of our deployment, in terms of our employment, and the protection which is required to protect our troops as well as the civilians in the border areas," he said.

Congress seeks CBI probe in CBSE's OSM-related controversy

Asks if bar was lowered to favour selected vendor

The Congress on Saturday demanded a CBI probe into alleged irregularities in the On-Screen Marking (OSM) system used to evaluate Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) papers. The bill centres after Rajni Gandhi alleged that the Centre lowered criteria for the selection of an evaluation agency, leading to poorly scanned answer sheets and partial failures.

Congress general secretary Jyoti Ramani said high-

lighted investigations by a select and a media report questioning why the board awarded the OSM contract within 24 days of the exams. He also noted that 36 technical concerns identified during a dry run in five Delhi schools were never addressed.

Ramani further questioned why a provision disqualifying bidders with poor performance records was removed, suggesting it was intended to favour COEMFT, a firm previously blacklisted in Telangana. He also ques-

tioned if the minimum turnover was set at Rs 50 crore to allow COEMFT to qualify, noting the company was chosen over more experienced vendors.

"It is increasingly clear that an astonishing mix of incompetence, corruption, and collusion were into the CBSE's planning," Ramani stated. Since the Selection General told the Supreme Court that the Prime Minister is supervising the issue, Ramani asserted the Prime Minister must answer to parents.

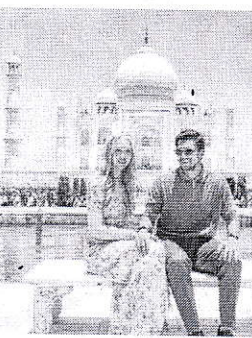
