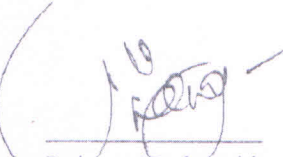

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Court grants bail to Lalu's wife Rabri, son Tejashwi in IRCTC scam case

New Delhi, A Delhi court today granted bail to RJD supremo Lalu Prasad's wife Rabri Devi and son Tejashwi Yadav in an Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) scam case. Special Judge Arun Bhargava also issued a production warrant against Prasad in the case.

The court granted bail to Rabri and Tejashwi Yadav on a personal bond of Rs one lakh and one surety of the like amount.

The next date of hearing has been set as October six.

Earlier the court had summoned and asked the Lalu family and others in the case to appear before the court today in the case related to alleged irregularities in granting operational contract of two IRCTC hotels to a private firm.

Lalu did not appear before the court today as he is in a Jharkhand jail in another case.

The CBI, which had on April 16 filed the charge sheet in the case, had said there were enough evidence against Lalu, Rabri, Tejashwi and others. The CBI had

earlier informed the court that sanction has been procured from authorities concerned to prosecute Additional Member of Railway Board B K Agarwal, who was then the group general manager of the IRCTC.

Besides Lalu Prasad and his family members, former Union minister Prem Chand Gupta and his wife Sarla Gupta, Agarwal, then managing director of IRCTC P K Goyal and then IRCTC director Rakesh Saxena were also named in the charge sheet.

The other names in the charge sheet include then group general managers of IRCTC V K Asthana and R K Goyal, and Vijay Kochhar, Vinay Kochhar, both directors of Sujata Hotels and owners of Chanakya Hotel.

Delight Marketing Company, now known as Lara Projects, and Sujata Hotels Private Limited have also been named as accused companies in the charge sheet. The CBI had registered a case in July last year and carried out searches at 12 locations in Patna, Ranchi,

Bhubaneswar and Gurgaon in connection with the case.

Rajkumar Rao on films that shaped his career

Mumbai, In a career spanning eight years, Rajkumar Rao has made a steady rise to the top, becoming one of the most distinctive and trusted actors of Hindi cinema.

Rao, who turned 34 today, believes "Shahid", "Trapped", "Newton" and "Bareilly Ki Barfi" are the four films that impacted his career the most.

"The characters in these films were real in a way. Though 'Shahid' was the only true story, what happened in 'Trapped' can happen to anyone. And I am sure there are people like Newton and there are boys who are naive, sweet and rowdy, like my part in 'Bareilly...'. The humanness is something I loved," the actor told PTI in an interview.

"Shahid", a 2013 biopic directed by Hansal Mehta, was based on the life of lawyer and human rights activist Shahid Azmi who was assassinated in 2010.

"...Hansal sir narrated me his story and on a human level, I was moved that there was somebody like him. That film also changed me as a person." He spent a lot of time with Shahid's family, trying to know him.

"Nearly 20-lakh MSME units make Gujarat's Industrial Strength" - Rupani

Ahmedabad, Gujarat Chief Minister Vijaybhai Rupani today said that Gujarat Government will set up 16 new GIDC Estates over 26,000 hectares in the State, including one at Khirasara in Rajkot district, over and above 20-lakh small and medium industries working in the state, to boost further industrial and job opportunities. Speaking at a function to mark the ground breaking ceremony of the Rs.7.70-crore Assist to Industrial Infrastructure (AII) project at Aji GIDC Estate in Rajkot, he said that the State Government will provide 80 per cent and the Association 20 per cent cost of AII. AII is to provide basic infrastructure like road resurfacing, covering open gutter lines, installing CCTV cameras, street light, underground water tank and roadside paver blocks. Mr. Rupani said that 70 per cent of MoUs signed during the Vibrant Gujarat Summit are for Small and Medium Scale Industrial Units. The state government plans to train 1-lakh apprentices in various trades, alongside skill development necessary for quality control. He presented agreement letters to apprentices, HK Industries and Amul Industries being the leading employers. The meeting began by paying tributes to late former Prime Minister Atak Bihari Vajpayee,

followed by tree plantation and cleanliness drive, distributing 1,100 dustbins. Aji GIDC Estate Association President Jeevanlal Patel presented Rs.1.51-lakh towards CM's Relief Fund. Rajkot's industrialists Sureshbhai Santoki, Mayurbhai Shah, Pravinbhai, Viratbhai, Parshottambhai Kamani were presented awards. New Delhi, Aligning to Hon. In Rajkot, it is being built in Kitipara locality. The new houses would be stronger, each beneficiary to get up to Rs.70,000. He directed RMC to provide water, light and gutter lines at Chhotunagar. He distributed documents to 287 persons at Amarjeetnagar, agreement letter to 59 clerks, and electricity allocation letters. Mr. Rupani said that his government is also concerned about the citizens' serious diseases, extending assistance up to Rs.3-lakh under MukhyaMantriAmritam, accident emergency treatment cost up to Rs.50,000, besides providing other assistance under Ujjwala, Saubhagya, Jandhan, etc.. He said that the state government has provided jobs to 72,000 youth during the last one year through transparent means, eliminating middlemen who forced people to mortgage property or ornaments.
