**Sub : Disclosure under Regulation 30 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India
(Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015**

Airbus has informed InterGlobe Aviation Limited ("IndiGo") about an issue on some of the engines powering its A320neo aircraft. Product Safety Boards of Pratt & Whitney and Airbus, post evaluating the PW1100G-JM engine issue, have decided that all neo deliveries are on hold till further notice. The issue impacts a limited sub population of engines and IndiGo had to ground 3 of its aircraft in the interim.

Like other Pratt & Whitney GTF engine powered A320neo operators globally, IndiGo continues to operate its other A320neo aircraft.

Airbus and Pratt & Whitney are working in close cooperation and will be swiftly communicating on the way forward in relation to aircraft deliveries.

Meanwhile, IndiGo will continue to add Airbus A320ceo and ATR aircraft to its fleet.
