Independent Auditor's Report

To the Board of Directors of Tata Elxsi Limited

Report on the audit of the Interim Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying quarterly financial results of Tata Elxsi Limited ("the Company") for the quarter ended 30 September 2024 and the year-to-date results for the period from 01 April 2024 to 30 September 2024, attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, these financial results:

- are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the net profit and other comprehensive loss and other financial information for the quarter ended 30 September 2024 as well as the year to date results for the period from 01 April 2024 to 30 September 2024.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing ("SAs") specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"). Our responsibilities under those SAs are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results* section of our report. The Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial results.

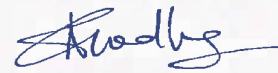
