Domino's Pizza and Dunkin' Donuts employees undertake the task of beach cleaning post Ganpati Visarjan

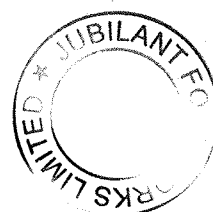
*Thousands of employees of Jubilant FoodWorks Limited participated in the cleaning drive
