Notice is hereby given to the Members of Megasoft Limited ('the Company'), pursuant to Section 108 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') read with Rule 20 and Rule 22 of Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014 and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, ('Listing Regulations') and other applicable provisions of the Act, Rules, Circulars and Notifications issued thereunder (including any statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force and as amended from time to time), that the Special Resolution as set out in this Notice is proposed for consideration by the Members of the Company for passing by means of Postal Ballot, only through remote voting by electronic means ('remote e-voting'):

SPECIAL BUSINESS - SPECIAL RESOLUTION:

Item No.1: To consider and approve sale/ transfer or otherwise disposal of the whole or substantially the whole of an undertaking of the Company

To consider and, if thought fit, with or without modification, to pass the following resolution as Special Resolution:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the provisions of Section 180 (1)(a) and Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, Regulation 37A of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and subject to other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, (including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force), the provisions of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, and such other approvals, consents and permissions being obtained, by both the buyer and seller, from the appropriate authorities to the extent applicable and subject to the approval of the shareholders and Banks/Lenders, of the Company and Buyer and any other statutory approvals, as defined hereinunder, and as recommended by the Audit / Risk Compliance Committee, the consent of the Members be and is hereby accorded to approve the sale, transfer or disposal of 100% of its shareholding in its Associate Company viz. Extrovis AG, Switzerland to Refex Life Sciences Private Limited (“buyer”), subject to such agreed covenants in the interest of the company, at a price aggregating to US \$ 15,000,000 (Fifteen Millions) in one or more tranches, towards its full consideration, on terms and conditions as may be agreed and such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the Board, from time to time.”

Authorities, including in respect of its requirements of the Central and / or State Government(s) and / or local authorities with effect from such date and in such manner as is decided by the Board to do all such other acts, deeds, matters and things as they may deem necessary and/or expedient to give effect to the above Resolution including without limitation, to settle any questions, difficulties or doubts that may arise in regard to sale and transfer of the Undertaking as they may in their absolute discretion deem fit.”

1. The Explanatory Statements and reasons for the proposed Special Resolution pursuant to Section 102(1) read with Section 110 of the Act setting out material facts are appended herein below.
2. The Company has appointed Mr. M. Damodaran, Managing Partner of M/s M Damodaran & Associates LLP, (COP 5081) Practicing Company Secretaries, to act as the Scrutinizer, for conducting the Postal Ballot process, in a fair and transparent manner.
3. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) vide Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020, Circular No. 2/2022 dated May 05, 2022, Circular No. 10/2022 and Circular No. 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022, Circular No. 02/2021 dated January, 13, 2021 and General Circular No. 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023 and General Circular No. 09/2024 dated September 19, 2024 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA Circulars) and Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) vide Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated May 12, 2020 Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020, Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2021/11 dated January, 15, 2021, Circular No. SEBI/HO/DDHS/DDHS_Div2/P/CIR/2022/079 dated June 03, 2022 and SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated January 5, 2023, SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/167 dated October 07, 2023, SEBI and SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/P/CIR/2024/133 dated October 03, 2024 had permitted Companies to conduct Annual General Meeting (AGM) during the year 2025 through video conferencing (VC) or Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM), advised companies to conduct postal ballot by sending e-mails to all its members who have registered their email addresses with the Company or depository/depository participants. Accordingly, this notice is being sent to members who have registered their email addresses.
4. In accordance with the aforesaid circulars, physical copy of the Notice along with Postal Ballot form and pre-paid business reply envelope will not be sent to the members for this Postal Ballot. The communication of the assent or dissent of the Members would take place through the process of remote e-voting only.
5. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as on **July 4, 2025**, being the cut-off date, are entitled to vote on the Resolution set forth in this Notice. A person who is not a member as on the cut-off date should treat this Notice of Postal Ballot for information purpose only.
6. All documents referred to in the accompanying Notice and Explanatory Statement shall be available for inspection electronically. Members seeking to inspect such documents can send an email to investors@megasoft.com.
7. In compliance with provisions of Section 108 and 110 and other applicable provisions of the Act read with rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014 and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, ('Listing Regulations') the Company is pleased to offer e-voting facility to all the Members of the Company. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for facilitating e-voting to enable the Shareholders to cast their votes electronically.
8. The members are requested to register/update their email addresses in respect of electronic holdings with the Depository Participants and in respect of physical holdings with the Company's Registrar and Share Transfer Agent Cameo Corporate Services Limited at "Subramanian Building" 1, Club House Road, Chennai-600002.

10. **The voting period begins at 09.00 hours IST on Tuesday, July 8, 2025 and ends at 17.00 hours IST on Wednesday, August 6, 2025. The e-voting module shall be disabled by Central Depository Services (India) Limited for voting thereafter.**
11. The Scrutinizer shall immediately after the conclusion of the e-voting period unblock the votes in presence of at least two witnesses not in the employment of the organization and will submit his report to the Executive

Director/ Company Secretary of the Company after completion of the scrutiny and the results of the voting by Postal Ballot. The Resolution, if passed by requisite majority shall be deemed to have been passed on **Wednesday, August 6, 2025** being the last date specified by the Company for receipt of duly completed Postal ballot e-voting.

12. The declared results along with the report of the scrutinizer shall be forwarded to the BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange Limited and shall be uploaded on the website of the Company i.e., www.megasoft.com within 2 working days of conclusion of postal ballot process.

14. The instructions for Shareholders for e-voting are as under:

1. Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242** dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/ retail shareholders is at a negligible level.
2. Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facilities to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.
3. In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.
4. In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
(PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013)

Item No.1:

The Board of Directors of the Company in its meeting held on July 1, 2025 has considered and approved the sale/transfer/disposal of the Company's share in its Associate Company subject to approval of members by way of special resolution.

The Company proposes to sell, transfer or disposal of 100% of its shareholding in its Associate Company viz. Extrovis AG, Switzerland i.e., (80,000 Equity Shares corresponding to 36.52% of the Paid Up Capital of Extrovis AG) to Refex Life Sciences Private Limited ("Buyer") subject to such agreed covenants in the interest of the company, at a price aggregating to US \$ 15,000,000 (Fifteen Millions) towards its full consideration, on terms and conditions mentioned below and on such other terms and conditions.

The proceeds from this sale will be utilized for the Company's growth by making investments in the opportunities available to the Company in the areas of Aerospace and Defence sector and for general corporate purposes. The Board of Directors have considered and reviewed the various options and approved the said proposal in the best interest of the company.

Under the provisions of Section 180(1)(a) of the Companies Act, 2013 (The Act), any sale/ transfer or otherwise disposal of the whole or substantially all of the undertaking of the Company requires the approval of the members of the Company by way of the special resolution. Further under the said provisions, an undertaking means an undertaking in which the investment of the Company exceeds 20% of its net worth as per the audited balance sheet of the preceding financial year or an undertaking that generates 20% of the total income of the Company during the previous financial year.

Hence, the sale/ transfer of the undertaking requires approval of the members by a special resolution under Section 180(1)(a) of the Act. Further, in terms of Regulation 37A of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), Regulations, 2015, as amended, (SEBI LODR), the consent of the shareholders for carrying out sale/ transfer or otherwise disposal of the whole or substantially the whole of the undertaking of such entity or where it owns more than one undertaking, of the whole or substantially the whole of any of such undertakings, shall be taken by the way of special resolution under Companies Act, 2013 read with applicable SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015.

Further in terms of the said regulations no public shareholder shall be entitled to vote on the resolution if he is a party, directly or indirectly, to such sale/ transfer or otherwise disposal of the whole or substantially the whole of the undertaking of the listed entity.

None of the Directors or Key Managerial Personnel or their relatives or promoter/promoter group companies is concerned or interested in the Resolution.

The Members may note that in terms of the provisions of the SEBI Listing Regulations, the related parties as defined thereunder (whether such related party(ies) is a party to the aforesaid transactions or not), shall not vote to approve resolution

Details as required pursuant to Regulation 37A of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 as applicable are provided hereunder.
