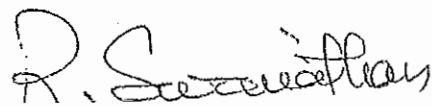

**WABAG secures Hybrid Annuity Order from Namami Gange worth
INR 575 Crore**

March 08, 2019: VA TECH WABAG LIMITED ('WABAG'), a leading Pure Play Water Technology Indian Multinational Company has secured INR 575 Crore worth order under the prestigious National Mission for Clean Ganga ('NMCG') Scheme to Design, Build, Rehabilitate and Operate Sewage Treatment Facilities and associated infrastructure in Kolkata, West Bengal.
