Desi advanced surveillance drone to be unveiled next wk

Flight-Test Of Weaponised Drone Soon

New Delhi: India's first indigenous advanced unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) for strategic reconnaissance and surveillance will make its public debut next week, while another home-grown weaponised drone is also slated to undertake its first flight test by June-July.

The Tapas-BH (tactical aerial platform) for advanced surveillance beyond horizon drone, developed by DRDO, with over 180 flights clocked till now, will live-stream the aerial and static display of dif-

ferent aircraft during the Aero-India show at Bengaluru. "Tapas-BH will showcase its capabilities, which includes operating at altitudes up to 28,000-feet with an endurance of over 18 hours."

The medium-altitude long-endurance (MALE) is DRDO's solution for ISR (intelligence, surveillance, target acquisition and reconnaissance) requirements of the Army, IAF and Navy, a

defence ministry official said on Thursday.

The armed drone called Archer-NG (next generation), which can carry 500 kg of weapons including smart air-to-air weapons (SAAWs) and anti-tank guided missiles, in turn, will be flight-tested for the first time by June-July sources said. The Tapas-BH drone, earlier called Ruston-2, has a maximum speed of 225 kmph with a 20.6-metre wingspan and "a command range" of 1,000-km with satellite-based communication. The UAV, also capable of night flying, is now getting ready for formal operational evaluation by the armed forces. It can thereafter go for production in large numbers by Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd, Bharat Electronics and others, a source said.

'102 people killed in jallikattu since 2017'

Nagpur: Jallikattu events have killed 102 people and 30 bulls since 2017, says a first-of-its-kind investigative report that could hinder the red rag for the bull-taming sport's opponents, reports **Manika Behl**.

According to 'Jallikattu Cult - Politics, Facts, Killings & Covid Deaths', published in 2017, by non-profit organisation *Non-Profit Organisation*, the human deaths included 81 spectators and passers-by, and 21 bull-tamers. A large number of schoolchildren also lost their lives.

The report, which captures information from the ground and news reports since 2017, highlighted the disturbing reality of the bull-taming sport held in Tamil Nadu. In a landmark judgment in 2014, the Supreme Court had banned the sport. However, in 2017, Tamil Nadu passed a state-level amendment to the central Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (PCA) Act, permitting jallikattu as "being intrinsic to Tamil culture".
