No interest in knowing who is at fault: Father of IAF officer killed in crash

THE FATHER OF Squadron Leader Ninad Mandavane, who was killed along with six others as an Mi-17 helicopter of the Indian Air Force crashed in central Kashmir's Budgam on February 27, has said that he is not interested in knowing who was at fault but that a thorough inquiry was necessary to ensure such incidents are not repeated again.

"I am not interested in knowing who is at fault and what punishment is given to them. But we want proper inquiry in this case so care must be taken to see that such incidents do not repeat. We have faith in Air Force to do it with utmost sincerity. My son has died in the battle and his death should be properly honoured," Anil Mandavane told The Indian Express.

The former banker said that he was informed by IAF officials within two days of the incident that the crash could have been a result of friendly fire.

"Two days after the incident, I was told by senior IAF officials as to what had actually happened. They had assured me that an inquiry was being consti-

tuted," Mandavane said.

Born in 1986, Ninad completed his initial studies at the Bhonsala Military School before joining Aungabadi's Services Preparatory Institute which was set up by the Maharashtra government to help train defence aspirants. He joined the IAF in 2009 and was promoted as Squadron Leader in 2015. He reportedly served in Gwalior and Gorakhpur before his assignment in Kashmir.

Ninad is survived by his wife Vijeta, a two-year-old daughter and parents Anil and Sushma. His brother Neerav is a chartered accountant and is based in Germany.

5-yr-old beaten to death; mother, stepfather held

THE TAMIL Nadu police on Wednesday arrested a 35-year-old mother and her second husband for allegedly murdering her five-year-old daughter in Kattupalli near Trichy on Monday, officers familiar with the matter said.

According to an initial investigation, the child was beaten to death with a coconut leaf stalk and a PVC pipe, they said.

While the mother, Nithya Karumuri, had initially claimed to hospital authorities that her daughter was beaten for not obeying and watching too much TV, an FIR filed by the police recorded the reason as a lack of interest in sports and physical exercise. Her second husband, Mudupandian, is a physical education teacher in the same school where she teaches.

A spouse officer probing the case, said Nithya and

Mudupandian were arrested under IPC section 302 for murder and the case is being investigated further as both the accused had issued contradictory statements.

"It was Mudupandian who had beaten the girl. Initially, their claim was that the mother had beaten the girl with a belt. But later, he admitted that he had punished her for showing no interest in sports training that he had enrolled her in. On Monday evening, when the girl refused to do the physical exercises and preferred to watch TV, they claimed that she started beating her. The mother was reportedly not at home when the incident happened. When she returned, she found that her daughter was unconscious. But, from the wounds on the girl's body, we suspect she was being tortured for at least two days," the officer said.

The duo then reportedly took the girl to the far left and at a primary health centre (PHC) at Kattupalli near their home.

INDIA ON Wednesday said the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Council of Foreign Ministers here in the Kyrgyz capital, External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj said India is determined to consistently strengthen cooperation within the SCO framework for comprehensive, cooperative and sustainable security.

Addressing the meeting of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Council of Foreign Ministers here in the Kyrgyz capital, External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj said India is determined to consistently strengthen cooperation within the SCO framework for comprehensive, cooperative and sustainable security.

"Our hearts go out to our brothers and sisters of Sri Lanka, who have recently witnessed the ghastly act of terrorism. Our wounds of Pulwama attack were still raw and the news from the neighborhood has made us more determined to resolutely fight against this menace," Swaraj said at the meeting, also attended by Pakistan Foreign Minister Shah Mehmood Qureshi.

Nine suicide bombers carried out a series of devastating blasts that tore through three churches and as many luxury hotels on April 21, killing more than 250 people and injuring 500 others. Swaraj said India is open to

ideas on how strengthening the work of the Regional Anti-Terrorism Structure (RATS), which specifically deals with issues relating to security and defence. In spite of a turbulent global scenario, SCO member states have been steadily expanding mutually beneficial cooperation in various spheres, including political, security and development, Swaraj said.

She said that India is committed to continue working for a favourable environment for the SCO member countries' economic activities and to intensify work on relevant documents dealing with economic and trade cooperation.

"India subscribes to a rule-based, transparent, non-discriminatory, open and inclusive multilateral trading system, centered around the World Trade Organisation, and firmly opposes unilateralism and protectionism," she said, adding the trade war between China and the United States of America (USA).

India has been an observer at the SCO since 2005 and has generally participated in ministerial-level meetings of the grouping which focus mainly on security and economic cooperation in the Eurasian region. Along with India, Pakistan was also granted SCO membership in 2017.

The grouping was founded at

a summit in Shanghai in 2001 by the presidents of Russia, China, Kyrgyz Republic, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan.

Advocating for advancement in technology, Swaraj said science-led innovation and a digital economy could play key roles in the long-term, inclusive and sustainable growth. India has adopted a multi-pronged welfare approach, which includes development of human resources, promoting R&D, enhancing efficiency through digital services and ensuring a secure cyber space.

Speaking on infrastructure projects, Swaraj said India is committed to regional connectivity.

2 Hizbul militants killed in encounter at Kulgam

TWO HIZBUL Mujahideen (HM) militants were killed in a pre-dawn gunbattle between Indian security forces in South Kashmir's Kulgam district on Wednesday.

A J&K police spokesperson said a cordon and search operation was launched in Gopajpora village, Kulgam on the early morning of Wednesday, following reports of presence of militants in the area.

During the search operation, police said, militants fired at security forces triggering an encounter.

In the gunbattle, which continued for several hours, two militants were killed, they added.

The slain militants were identified as Zahid Ahmad Mantoo and Irfan Manzoor, while Zahid, a resident of nearby Shopian district, was active since 2018, sources said. Irfan who hails from Kulgam district was a new recruit and had joined the militant ranks recently.

According to Police, Zahid

was involved in several cases in the area.

"Several terror crime cases were registered against him," said the spokesperson. Police said that he was also involved in a case pertaining to the killing of three policemen at Batgram, Shopian last year.

Irfan police said he joined the militant outfit recently and was involved in the killing of one man at Shopian in Kulgam district last month.

After the encounter, clashes also took place in the area, involving at least one youth sustained

AGUSTA WESTLAND CHOPPER CASE

ED files supplementary charges against 'agent' Sushen Gupta

THE ENFORCEMENT Directorate (ED) on Wednesday filed a supplementary chargesheet before a Delhi special court against alleged defence agent Sushen Gupta, alleging that the accused is directly connected to laundering of kickbacks in the Augusta Westland VIP chopper deal case.

The chargesheet, filed before Special Judge Arvind Kumar, states that Gupta had direct dealings with M/s Interstellar Technologies, and the kickbacks were allegedly transferred to several entities or people who were directly linked to him.

Gupta, arrested under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) on March 23, is in judicial custody at present. He moved a bail application soon after the chargesheet was filed. The court will hear it on Thursday.

Gupta was arrested on the basis of information provided to ED by Rajeev Saxena, another accused who has turned approver in the case. Saxena has been granted pardon on condition that he will disclose information to the authorities.

ED had arrested Saxena in January this year. He is accused of floating several companies to route kickbacks to "var-

ious political persons, bureaucrats and Air Force officials" to influence the deal in favour of Augusta Westland.

The agency is investigating allegations of money laundering in a defence deal signed by the then UPA government with UK-based helicopter manufacturing company. The Rs 3,600-crore deal was for the purchase of 12 AW109 helicopters for the Indian Air Force. The deal was scrapped in 2014.

Gupta's arrest is the third major development in the case. In December 2018, the ED had extradited British national Michel Christian, a key accused, from the UAE. The 54-year-old is accused of brokering the deal between officials of Augusta Westland and Indian politicians.

Earlier, the agency had claimed before the court during Sushen Gupta's custodial remand that he was "misguiding the investigation by deliberately going into the details of his shareholdings in his shares, in which the abbreviation 'RG' had transition in many pages as well as in pen drive data," the ED had stated.

The agency submitted: "More than Rs 50 crores shown to have been received from 'RG' between 2004 to 2016, whereas the 'RG' identified by Sushen C. Rajat Gupta had admitted to have cash transaction with Sushen from 2007 onwards and the same are being quantified."

New MPs to be lodged in Western Court, state Bhavans

NEWLY-ELECTED MEMBERS of the 17th Lok Sabha will be lodged in the Western Court, its newly-built Annex and State Bhavans, doing away with the system of providing them transport accommodation in free-stay hotels.

Secretary-General Shrinivas Shrivastava, who made the announcement on Wednesday, said the move would help save money. In the 16th Lok Sabha, over 300 people were elected for the first time. Since the outgoing members took time to vacate their official residence, the Government was forced to make arrangements for the new members' stay in hotels. Sources disclosed that it cost the exchequer Rs 30 crore. Taking note, the House Committee proposed that 88 new officials and a two-level stay facility be added in the Western Court. At least 265 rooms will be made available to new MPs in state bhavans.

The counting of votes is scheduled for Thursday and the new members are expected to arrive in Delhi on Friday. The process for the election of the new prime minister and the swearing-in of the government will start thereafter.

Shrivastava said registration formalities and all papers related to salaries, allowances and a host of other matters would be completed at a single desk. The Secretariat has also set up helpdesks at all three terminals of transport and railway stations in the Capital.

SC grants protection from arrest to BJP candidate till May 28

THE SUPREME COURT on Wednesday granted protection from arrest till May 28 to Arjun Singh, a BJP candidate from Barrackpore constituency in West Bengal, in various criminal cases lodged against him by the state police.

The top court said no coercive action was to be taken against Singh, a four-time MLA, as it took note of widespread violence in the politically sensitive Bengal during the Lok Sabha polls.

A vacation bench comprising Justices Anil Mishra and D.R. Shinde said that Singh, who had been arrested by the state police till May 28 from Wednesday and granted him liberty to approach the appropriate forum for bail after the apex court's protection ceases.

While granting protection to Singh, who has left the ruling Trinamool Congress party to contest Lok Sabha polls on a BJP ticket, the bench took note of ongoing indefinite lawyers' strike in the state since April 25, which has paralysed the judicial work.

"No coercive action be taken against the petitioner (Arjun Singh) for a period commencing from today till May 28 with regard to all the cases registered against him," the bench said.

After having dictated the order, Justice Mishra remarked: "People who indulge in arson and rioting do not belong to a party. They join the party in power to commit violence."

Senior advocate Ranjit Kumar, appearing for Singh, alleged political vindictiveness on part of the state government and said 21 cases have been registered against him from April 4 to May 20.

He said in five of the cases, he has been granted bail, but more cases have been registered against Singh after he joined BJP.

Counsel for the West Bengal government said cases for rioting and arson were lodged against him.

The bench told the state government court that it was inclined to grant protection from arrest to the petitioner (Singh) to enable him to be present for counting of votes on Thursday as he was a candidate for the parliamentary elections.

The bench, while asking as to why Singh wanted to go to West Bengal, in the forenoon observed: "Lot of violence is taking place there. You (Singh) know very well."

Kumar said he was a candidate from Barrackpore Lok Sabha seat and wanted to be present during counting of votes.

Two die after inhaling poisonous gases while cleaning grain silo, two arrested

TWO MEN died when they entered a grain silo (gran storage) for cleaning and were knocked unconscious by toxic gases that had built up inside over the past nine months. The incident took place inside a food grain factory in North West Delhi's Lawrence Road Industrial Area Tuesday night, police said.

Over the past two days, workers were doing deep cleaning, removing harvesting pits and efficient treatment plants. However, this is the first case

where two men died due to silo gas trapped in the storage unit containing chemicals.

Police identified the two dead men as Balraj Khan (30), who worked as a quality control supervisor, and Mohan Khan (26), a machine operator. Both men were taken to a nearby hospital but they died before being taken to the hospital.

The factory has several branches in Delhi and other states. The Lawrence Road factory has four floors and a terrace where machines are kept. Police

claimed that the silo, located in the basement, is 12x12 ft and has a narrow well covering the top.

According to relatives of the victims, they had around 10 men working inside them and had no business cleaning the grain silo. In an interview, a relative who had previously conducted quality control checks at the factory, said, "They should not have been sent to clean the silo. It was dangerous work," he said.

Police claimed that the owner decided to open the grain silo due to increased demand in chickpeas. It also learnt that Mohan had cleaned another grain silo just two days ago and had con-

sumed a headache.

Police and Delhi Fire Services were informed about the incident, following which a team from the DFSS pulled out the two men in an hour-long operation.
