

Earthquake of magnitude 5.3 strikes Mizoram

New Delhi An earthquake of 5.3 hit Mizoram at 4:10 am on Monday. The depth of the quake was 20 km while the coordinates of the epicentre are 23.22 (latitude) and 93.24 (longitude).

"Earthquake of magnitude:5.3; Occurred on 22-06-2020, 04:10:52 IST; Lat: 23.22 and Long: 93.24; Depth: 20 Km; Location: 27 km SSW of Champhai, Mizoram, India," the National Centre for Seismology tweeted.

Tremors were felt in the north-east for the second consecutive day. On Sunday, the Earth Science Department of Manipur University said that a 5.1 quake hit Manipur at 4:16 PM with the epicentre 9 km from Ngopa area in Mizoram. No loss of life or damage to property has been reported in Manipur so far, the DGP Control Room told a news agency. The National Centre for Seismology (NCS) marked Sunday's earthquake as 'reviewed' while confirming that the epicentre was 25 km east northeast (ENE) of Aizawl in Mizoram. The depth of the quake was 35 km while the coordinates of the epicentre are 23.80 (latitude) and 92.26 (longitude). On June 18, a medium intensity quake pegged at a magnitude of 5 rocked northeastern states. In a statement, the Regional Seismic Centre said that the tremor was tracked at a depth of 80 km from the earth's surface with the epicentre in Mizoram's Champhai district. Coronavirus: Containment zones in Delhi to be mapped again, says MHA



New Delhi A high-level committee set up by Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Sunday recommended mapping of all containment zones in Delhi again for better management of the Covid-19 situation and vigorous contact tracing positive cases. Amit Shah advised the Delhi government to implement the recommendations of VK Paul Committee. The committee has recommended mapping of containment zones in Delhi again and a strict vigil on activities inside such areas, the home ministry said in a statement. The committee also suggested that there will be vigorous contact tracing of Covid-19 positive cases and such contacts will be quarantined, it said. The report of the committee was discussed at a high-level meeting chaired by Union Home Minister Amit Shah and attended by Delhi Lieutenant Governor Anil Bajjal, Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal among others. In the meeting, Amit Shah advised the Delhi government to implement the report. The committee headed by VK Paul, member Niti Aayog, was set up by Amit Shah on June 14.

Anguish slips through Chinese censors on PLA losses

New Delhi As Beijing continues to withhold official information about its casualties in the deadly June 15 face-off with India, Chinese citizens are expressing their frustration over the lack of reporting about the losses. An open-source analysis of Chinese social-media platforms shows how the citizens have poured their anguish over Beijing's tight regulations online. Unlike China, the Indian democracy has announced it lost 20 of its soldiers in the hand-to-hand combat with the Chinese troops in the Galwan Valley. For the families, friends of the PLA soldiers posted in the region, and the ordinary citizens of China alike the situation is still shrouded in mystery. Their online outpourings, some of them subtle for apparent fears of consequences, suggest they are growing anxious as official statements neither confirm nor deny casualties from the June 15 fighting. Chinese Netizens Pour It Out on Weibo. Weibo is China's own Twitter. An analysis of communications happening on the micro-blogging site reveals that the Chinese citizens are mostly sharing Indian images, news articles and videos linked to the Galwan Valley clash. Neither the Chinese state-controlled media nor the government have gone on the record to explain the

bloody event in detail. Let us look at some of the comments with translations: Chinese netizens demand transparency when it comes to PLA casualties or injuries. They would rather appreciate India for keeping its public up to speed on the losses. "India has held a memorial service for the sacrificial soldiers. It shows the high respect and attention of the whole country of India to the soldiers who defend the country and the land," a Chinese Weibo user posted on June 19. "It shows the high degree of solidarity of the Indian nation. What about us? We should learn from India and show respect to our soldiers. Why don't we openly hold memorial services for the soldiers who died? What? 0 deaths of the PLA? Have the injured been transported? Excuse me?" The Chinese soldiers are strictly banned from divulging any information to family or friends. This seems to have resulted in a lot of uncertainty with regards to their whereabouts and well-being. "I have been concerned about the situation between China and India since yesterday. From the videos and articles of overseas news, what I am most concerned



about is our young soldiers of the People's Liberation Army, whether there are casualties as no specific figures have been announced (India has announced the deaths of 20+ Indian soldiers with photos), our Chinese border guards and soldiers must be very young youths, having concerned parents, (very much in my heart)," read another Weibo post. "We patriots are even more worried about your comforting compatriots in the motherland and hope you are safe. You are the pride of our motherland! Thank you all!" A few Chinese netizens are

uncomfortable with some in the local social-media circles mocking the sacrifice of Indian soldiers. "In the case of conflict with India, hundreds of soldiers are involved. Even if we have strict discipline and hard training, we are all flesh after all. It is estimated that many of our soldiers too have injuries," a Chinese netizen wrote. "Looking at those cheering and mocking at the Indian casualties, it makes me feel happy and sad. The families of these fighters must be very nervous now." Upon two days after the Galwan Valley clash, the Chinese netizens started getting worried about PLA soldiers. "Care is not flashy statements. It is about taking care of the needs of the soldiers and improving their training equipment," read a reply. Relatives started posting online about their grievances, saying troops in the Ladakh region were not contactable. "Soldiers and their families need to be taken care of well. The families will be very worried," said a note in Weibo thread. "Very worried about the soldiers. No information on their well being. Families are very worried," read another.

SC to hear today 16 pleas seeking recall of its order staying Jagannath Rath Yatra in Puri

New Delhi The Supreme Court on Monday will hear a total of 16 pleas seeking a review of its order staying this year's Jagannath's Rath Yatra in Odisha amid the novel coronavirus pandemic. An application was also filed by 'Jagannath Sanskruti Jana Jagarana Manch' which sought recall and modification of the June 18 order, saying the festival is deeply associated to the religious beliefs of millions of devotees of Lord Jagannath and it is "not impossible and impracticable" for the state and district administration to conduct the Rath Yatra by maintaining social distancing and following the Centre's guidelines. In its separate application, the 'Jagannath Sanskruti Jana Jagarana Manch' said that as per the earlier direction of the Orissa High Court as well as the decision of the state government, 372 people were engaged in the construction of three raths/chariots for more than one-and-half months and all were isolated, tested and found Covid-19 negative. BJP spokesperson Sambit Patra and a 19-year-old Muslim student from Odisha are also among those who moved the Supreme Court seeking recall of its order

staying the historic yatra. Meanwhile, Vishva Hindu Parishad (VHP) general secretary Milind Parande said on Sunday that the Jagannath Rath Yatra should be allowed and as it can be held with all Covid-19 protocols. The VHP spokesperson further said it is the responsibility of the Odisha government to take proper steps to ensure the continuity of this yatra, which is the tradition of Odisha and the entire country. Now, a single-judge bench of Justice S Ravindra Bhat is scheduled to hear these applications on Monday.

On June 18, the Supreme Court had said that in the interest of public health and safety of citizens, this year's rath yatra, which was scheduled for June 23, in Puri, Odisha, cannot be allowed and "Lord Jagannath won't forgive us if we allow" it. Chief Justice of India SA Bobde had then said: "Lord Jagannath won't forgive us if we allow this year's Rath Yatra to go on, as such a huge gathering can't take place during the pandemic." After the Supreme Court's verdict, the Odisha government had decided to abide by its order to not hold

Jagannath Rath Yatra in Puri this year keeping in view the novel coronavirus pandemic. The state government then came under pressure amid growing demands from different quarters for holding a "devotee-less" festival, instead of giving it a miss. Following this, the Odisha government said that it will take "favourable action" as legally permissible on a request by Gajapati Maharaja Dibyasingha Deb that Lord Jagannath's Rath Yatra be allowed sans congregation of devotees. The Shankaracharya of Puri, Swami Nischalananda Saraswati, alleged that there was a well-orchestrated plan to stall Lord Jagannath's Rath Yatra this year amidst the Covid-19 pandemic. "The Supreme Court could have voluntarily accepted the petitions on June 20. While the court remains open during the vacation period to hear important cases, Rath Yatra is to be held on Tuesday. So, there lies only a single day [Monday] in between. Non-acceptance of the petitions by the court indicates a pre-meditated set-up and well-orchestrated move to cancel Rath Yatra of Lord Jagannath," Shankaracharya said.
