Delhi battles water level crisis in Yamuna

New Delhi: Delhi is battling a crisis with the water level in the Yamuna at Wazirabad dropping almost three feet below the desired level due to unbridled illegal sand mining in the Yamuna river in the state of Haryana and the situation may worsen amid a prediction of extreme heat this year.

Delhi Jal Board Vice-Chairman Sarubh Bhardwaj inspected the Wazirabad Water Treatment Plant (WTP) on Tuesday as the water level in the Yamuna river continues to fall. The condition of Yamuna today is usually seen in the months of April and May in Delhi.

Bhardwaj alleged that the key reason for the water level decrease in Yamuna is not rising temperatures but the rampant illegal sand mining being done indiscriminately in the Yamuna river in the state of Haryana. The AAP MLA, who will soon take an oath as Delhi Cabinet minister, disclosed that the sand mafia had stopped Yamuna water released for Delhi in an area of about 7-8 km from Yamuna.

Nagar that lies in Haryana, where the sand mafia is indiscriminately mining sand in the Yamuna river. "The sand mafia has made temporary bridges in the middle of the Yamuna River for illegal mining and the movement of trucks. It has also dug illegal big pits in the river bed by digging out the sand in huge quantities, due to which the Yamuna water is not reaching Delhi in sufficient quantity. Bhardwaj said that as per the court's order, mining in Yamuna is completely illegal," he said.

Targeting the Haryana Government, Bhardwaj asked why the Haryana Government is not looking at the illegal business which is happening there indiscriminately and why the Haryana Government is ignoring the illegal sand mining in Yamuna.

Prof Pushpendrapal Singh passes away, last rites held

Former Professor of Makhanaal Chaturvedi National University of Journalism (Bhopal) Pushpendra Pal Singh passed away on Tuesday after suffering two heart attacks. Prof Pushpendra Pal Singh was also the editor of the 'Rozgar Aur Nirman' newspaper. He was also the President of the Public Relations Society of India (PRSI) and was popularly known as 'PP Sir' among his students.

There is a wave of mourning in the literary world after the news of Pushpendra Pal Singh's death came out. Along with teaching countless students of journalism, Prof. Pushpendra Pal also helped a lot of his students in getting jobs.

He had a deep attachment to literary-cultural activities. His last rites will be performed today at 12-30 pm at Bhadracharya Vishramghat. CM Shivraj Singh Chouhan also condoled his death.

Madhya Pradesh CM Shivraj Singh Chouhan termed his death a big loss for the Hindi journalism world.

"Pushpendra Pal Singh ji was like a friend and family to me, his untimely departure is my personal loss. An able, simple and hardworking personality, who was given any responsibility, he did it with excellence," he wrote in his tweet.

Prof. Pushpendra Pal Singh was an institution of journalism in himself, he taught journalism to many students in Madhya Pradesh and outside. The loss of an able Guru, popularly known as 'PP Sir' among the students, came as a shock.

CM instructs district Collectors to conduct survey of damaged crops due to hailstorm

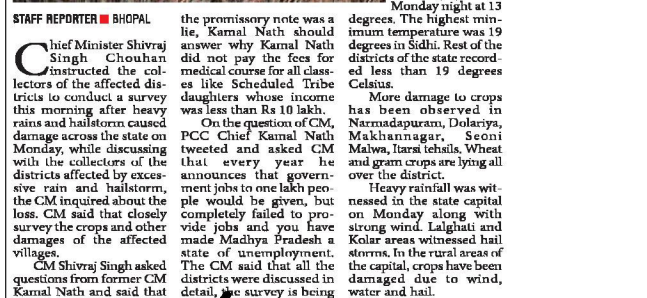

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan instructed the collectors of the affected districts to conduct a survey this morning after heavy rains and hailstorm caused damage across the state on Monday, while discussing with the collectors of the districts affected by excessive rain and hailstorm, the CM inquired about the loss. CM said that closely survey the crops and other damages of the affected districts.

CM Shivraj Singh asked questions from former CM Kamal Nath and said that the promissory note was a lie, Kamal Nath should answer why Kamal Nath did not pay the fees for medical course for all classes like Scheduled Tribe daughters whose income was less than Rs 10 lakh.

On the question of CM, PCC Chief Kamal Nath tweeted and asked CM that every year he announces that government jobs to one lakh people would be given, but completely failed to provide jobs and you have made Madhya Pradesh a state of unemployment. The CM said that all the districts were discussed in detail, the survey is being

done for the farmers. The weather has changed in the state for the last 3 days. Almost half of the districts in the state have become waterlogged. It also rained in Raigarh, Ujjain, Chhindwara, Vidisha. Two deaths have also occurred in Shajapur and Ujjain districts due to lightning. The lowest temperature in the state was recorded at Narsinghpur on Monday night at 13 degrees. The highest minimum temperature was 19 degrees in Sidhi. Rest of the districts of the state recorded less than 15 degrees Celsius.

Delhi Mayor inspects Mata Gujri hospital on Tuesday

New Delhi: Delhi Mayor Dr Shelly Oberoi Tuesday inspected the Mata Gujri Hospital, Tilak Nagar in West Zone and took stock of medical facilities and services being provided by the hospital.

Along with MLA Tilak Nagar Jarnail Singh, Zonal DC Anand Kumar, DC(Health) Pradeep Kumar, local councillor Ashok Maan, senior officials of Hospital Administration and senior doctors were present on the occasion.

Later, she chaired a meeting with officials of the assessment and collection (A & C) department of the municipal corporation, and reviewed schemes related to property tax.

During the inspection, Dr Oberoi interacted with the patients and sought their feedback on the facilities available in the hospital. She visited several wards including Dialysis Centre, Laboratory, PICU Ward, Maternity & Infant care Unit, Step Down Nursery, Gynae OPD and Operation Theatre. She asked the patients and their attendants if they are able to avail the services prop-

erly or not and took feedback on the treatment. Senior doctors explained to the Mayor about the whole functioning of the hospital and told how amenities could be made more advanced and modern. The Mayor stressed upon the need of improved facilities and advanced diagnostic equipments at the hospital.

She suggested that the information about the modern services available in the Tilak Nagar hospital should be widely disseminated so that people at large can avail them optimally. She also appreciated the good work done by the hospital staff & doctors.

After the inspection Dr Oberoi congratulated the doctors for the upkeep of the hospital. She said that the hospital administration and doctors have had to take the initiative to scale up the infrastructure on their own with the help of CSR funds. & Given that this hospital had minimal support from previous governments, what the hospital staff has done through only CSR funds is appreciable.
