Indian-origin man sentenced to 23 months' jail for cheating through Singapore online marketplace

SINGAPORE : (AGENCY)

An Indian-origin man has been sentenced to 23 months' jail for cheating a woman he met on Singapore's online marketplace of over SGD268,000. Thevendran Elan Goven, 31, was handed the sentence on Thursday, after he earlier pleaded guilty to one count of cheating. The Straits Times reported Two other similar charges were taken into consideration.

Deputy Public Prosecutor Suriya Prakash told the court previously that Thevendran did not stop cheating the victim even after all her money was gone. The court heard that the victim was 25 years old at the time of the offences, according to the Singapore daily report. On or before July 24, 2021, Thevendran posted a listing on Carousell for a PlayStation 4 (PS4), and the



victim responded. He told her the game console would be delivered within seven days if she paid a deposit of SGD150, and said she had to pay a balance of another SGD150 after it was delivered. The woman transferred SGD150 to Thevendran on July 24, 2021. The pair continued

messaging on Carousell about unrelated matters before continuing their conversation on WhatsApp. Three days later, he asked her to pay the remaining SGD150 for the console, which he had not delivered, and an additional SDG49 for some PS4 games. The victim complied and trans-

ferred SGD199, but did not receive the items. Thevendran continued to message the victim on WhatsApp and began calling her. The victim believed that she had fostered a friendship with him. Between August and December 2021, he cheated her of more than

SGD246,000 in total over 48 occasions. He lied to her that he needed to borrow money for various reasons, including to fund his "court case", for his dental bill, to pay his supplier, and even because his dog was sick. In reality, he used these ill-got gains to fund personal expenses and settle gambling debts. By August that year, he came to know that she had received a sum of money from insurance and Central Provident Fund payouts following her mother's death. American officials arrive in Oman as Iran, US set for talks over Tehran's nuclear programme

MUSCAT : (AGENCY)

A convoy believed to be carrying American officials arrived on Friday at the site of talks between Iran and the United States where the two countries are set to hold negotiations over Tehran's nuclear programme. The



talks on Friday come after a chaotic week that initially saw plans for regional countries to take part in talks in Turkiye. The two countries have returned to Oman, a sultanate on the eastern edge of the Arabian Peninsula, months after rounds of meetings turned to ash following Israel's launch of a 12-day war against Iran back in June. The US bombed Iranian nuclear sites during that war, likely destroying many of the centrifuges that spun uranium to near weapons-grade purity. Israel's attacks decimated Iran's air defences and targeted its ballistic missile arsenal as

well. The American convoy drove into a palace on the outskirts of Muscat, near its international airport. One of the vehicles flew American flags. Vehicles that carried Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi arrived earlier, with Iranian state television saying he was meeting with Omani Foreign Minister Badr al-Busaidi. That convoy later left for a hotel being used by the Iranians near the airport. The same palace had been used by Oman in earlier talks between Iran and the US in 2025. US officials like Secretary of State Marco Rubio believe Iran's theocracy is now at its weakest point since its 1979 Islamic Revolution. after nationwide protests last month represented the greatest challenge to 86-year-old Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei's rule. Khamenei's forces responded with a bloody crackdown that killed thousands and reportedly saw tens of thousands arrested - and spurred new military threats by US President Donald Trump to target the country. With the aircraft carrier USS Abraham Lincoln and other warships in the region.

Uber ordered to pay \$8.5 million in trial over driver sex assault claims

CHICAGO : (AGENCY)

A US jury ordered Uber on Thursday to pay \$8.5 million after finding it liable in a lawsuit brought by a woman who said she was sexually assaulted by a driver when she was 19, a verdict that could influence thousands of similar cases against the ride-hailing company. The case, brought by plaintiff Jaylynn Dean, was the first trial - known as a bellwether - of more than 3,000 similar lawsuits against Uber that have been consolidated in US federal court. Bellwether trials are used to test legal theories and help gauge the value of claims for possible settlements. The jury in federal court in Phoenix, Arizona, found that the driver was an agent of Uber, holding the company responsible for his actions. They awarded Dean \$8.5 million in compensatory damages but declined to award punitive damages. Attorneys for Dean had sought more than \$140 million in damages. Uber's shares dipped 1.5% in after-hours trading. Shares of rival Lyft, which is facing lawsuits making similar claims, were down 1.8%. In a statement, an Uber spokesperson said the



company would appeal and noted the jury rejected Dean's other claims, that the company was negligent or that its safety systems were defective.

"This verdict affirms that Uber acted responsibly and has invested meaningfully in rider safety," the spokesperson said. Sarah London, an attorney for Dean, said the verdict "validates the thousands of survivors who have come forward at great personal risk to demand accountability against Uber for its focus on profit over passenger safety." Dean, an Oklahoma resident, sued Uber in 2023, one month after her alleged assault in Arizona. She said Uber was aware of a wave of sexual assaults committed by its drivers, but had failed to take basic actions to

improve the safety of its riders. Such assertions have long dogged the company, drawing headlines and congressional scrutiny. Alexandra Walsh, an attorney for Dean, said during the trial's closing arguments that Uber had marketed itself as a safe option for women traveling at night, particularly if they had been drinking. "Women know it's a dangerous world. We know about the risk of sexual assault," Walsh said. "They made us believe that this was a place that was safe from that." Uber, which has faced numerous safety controversies, including allegations of lax driver vetting and a culture critics said prioritized growth over passenger protection, has argued it should not be held liable for criminal con-

More storms coming as Leonardo swells rivers, bursts aquifers in Spain and Portugal

GRAZALEMA : (AGENCY)

Authorities in southern Spain have evacuated residential areas out of fear a major river could overflow and warned of landslides caused by bursting aquifers on Friday after Storm Leonardo swept over the Iberian Peninsula. Over 7,000 people have been forced to leave their homes in the Andalusia region so far amid a so-called "storm train" in which several consecutive storms have pounded Portugal and Spain with torrential rains and strong winds over the past weeks.

State weather agency AEMET warned that another storm, Marta, would hit the peninsula on Saturday, bringing more abundant rainfall.

Several residential areas near the Guadalquivir riverbed in Cordoba province were evacuated overnight due to the dramatic rise in water levels. Also evacuated were the approximately 1,500 resi-



dents of Grazalema, a mountain village popular with hikers, as water seeped through the walls of houses and cascaded along steep cobbled streets.

Andalusia's regional leader, Juan Manuel Moreno, told radio station SER that aquifers in the Grazalema mountains were full and could provoke landslides due to pent-up pressure. "This could cause large holes or ditches. If this happens under a house or street, the result could be dramatic," Moreno said. He added geologists were assessing the situation in Grazalema to determine

when residents would be able to return to their homes. The heavy rains are also impacting the olive harvest. Francisco Elvira, who leads farmers' association COAG in Jaen province, estimated losses worth 200 million euros (\$236 million) so far.

In Portugal's second-biggest city Porto, the River Douro overflowed in the early hours on Friday, causing minor flooding at riverside cafe terraces. In the country's south, large parts of the town of Alcaer do Sal by the River Sado remained semi-submerged for the third straight day.

Tropical storm leaves 4 dead in Philippines, over 6,000 displaced after flooding

PHILIPPINES : (AGENCY)

A tropical storm set off flooding and a landslide in the southern Philippines, leaving at least four people dead, displacing more than 6,000 and trapping residents in houses in two flooded villages, officials said on Friday. Tropical Storm Penha slammed ashore onto the southeastern province of Surigao del Sur from the Pacific late on Thursday. It was last



tracked on Friday around noon off central Bohol province with sustained winds of up to 55 kilometres (34 miles) per hour and gusts of up to 70 kph (43mph), according to forecasters.
