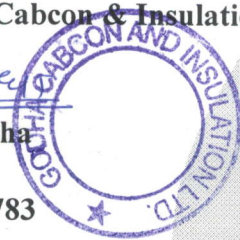

NEW DELHI The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and the Congress are projected to poll 39 per cent and 34 per cent votes, respectively, in Punjab, which is going to the polls next year, as per the third ABP News-CVoter Battle for the States Tracker.

For all the political and social turmoil witnessed in the state, the electorate is remarkably split in its expression. If this situation continues to hold for another month, then we may see a hung Vidhan Sabha in Punjab with AAP emerging as the single largest party, closely followed by Congress.

BJP LEADS CONGRESS BY THIN MARGIN IN MANIPUR

Manipur is a close contest and the BJP and the Congress are locked in a close battle. They are projected to poll 38 per cent and 34 per cent votes, respectively, as per the third ABP News-CVoter Battle for the States Tracker. The BJP has led the Congress consistently, albeit by a thin margin, as per the Tracker.

SPLIT VERDICT IN GOA WITH BJP AS SINGLE LARGEST PARTY

The BJP is expected to emerge as the single largest party with 30 per cent vote share in Goa, which will go to the polls early next year, as per the third ABP News-CVoter Battle for the States Tracker. The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) is projected to be the main opposition with 24 per cent vote share, while erstwhile prime contender Congress is projected to poll 20 per cent votes. It is clear from the vote share that Goa is heading for a split verdict that could eventually lead to a hung Assembly, as per the survey.

5 drone schools... "With this, farmers can avoid the ill-effects of harmful chemicals. This technology is also less expensive. Drone technology saves up to 25 percent of manure", he added. CM said drone technology had proved to be very helpful during the recent floods in some districts of state. The rescue operations were carried out with help of drones. Drones were also used in rescue work in the incident of sinking of a well in Ganjapada of Vidisha district.

PM inaugurates... The PM also took a jibe at Akhlesh Yadav who has often claimed that the works of his govt are being projected as the achievements of the BJP govt, saying that he was waiting if anyone will claim the credit for Saryu Canal Project. "When I started from Delhi, I was waiting for someone to say that he had cut the ribbon of this project and started this scheme. This is habit of some names, maybe in their childhood they had cut its ribbon," he said, without taking any names.

Farmers head... Two farmers from Punjab's Muktsar district were killed when the tractor-trailer was hit by a truck in Haryana's Hisar while they were returning home from the protest site at Tikri border. Police said one farmer was seriously injured in the accident at Hisar's Dhandoor village. Addressing farmers at the Ghazipur protest site, Svaraj India president Yogendra Yadav equated the four Hindu 'dhams' (holy sites) with the four border protest sites — Tikri, Singhu, Ghazipur and Shahjahanpur (Delhi-Jaipur border). "Now we will not speak but books and history will speak. This entire nation will speak. Today is just the day to remember that since last one year, the meaning of 'four dhams' has changed in our country. "People from Maharashtra, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu used to come and say they wanted to do yatra of four places... Singhu border, Tikri border, Ghazipur border and Shahjahanpur border...These (protest sites) had become the four dhams of this country," Yadav said. Although these "dhams" will be emptied in the coming two-three days, they will always stay in the hearts of the people, he said. Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal took to Twitter to praise the farmers for their effort. "There is no substitute for patience, courage and unity. Only by mutual brotherhood and unity, the country move forward. This unity of farmer brothers was their biggest strength. My salute to the strong will and vitality of the farmer brothers who are returning home from today with a historic victory," he said.

Cogent reasoning... Speaking for the bench, Justice Mrs Nagarathna in a judgment pronounced on Thursday said the right to appeal is a "creature of the Statute" and hence a "duty is cast on the Appellate Court to adjudicate a first appeal both on questions of fact and applicable law" and the re-appreciation of evidence in light of the contentions raised by the respective parties and judicial precedent and the law applicable to the case have to be "conscientiously dealt with." The Bench set aside the December 8, 2008 judgment of the Madras High Court, restoring January 14, 2000, judgment of the trial court. The matter related to the issuance of the grant of Letters of Administration in respect of the will of a deceased. Observing that the paragraphs in the High Court judgment were written in "cryptic manner", the top court said that the High Court has dealt with the judgment of the Trial Court in a "short-cut method, bereft of all reasoning" while reversing the judgment of the Trial Court both on facts as well as law.

With tiger pug marks in coal area, govt under fire for nod to mining

AVDRESH MALLICK / Raipur The Chhattisgarh government has recently consented for stage II forest clearance for coal mining in Parsa Coal Block in Hasdeo Arand area. The stage II forest clearance, will pave the way for opening of four coal mines Parsa East Kete Basan (operational stage 1), Parsa, Parsa Kete Extension, and Tara Coal Block have been increased. But the recent sightings of tiger and tiger movement in Hasdeo Arand area has increased the troubles for the Chhattisgarh government, which is continuously struggling to claim that the declining figure of tigers in the state is stable. The villagers and wildlife lovers circulated the photographs of tiger presence including pugmarks in jungles of Botopal, which is a part of Hasdeo Arand area. However, the forest department has not made any official statement in the case yet.



As per information received, the state government has recently given consent for stage two clearance for mining in the vulnerable Hasdeo Arand zone on the report tabled by Indian Council of Forestry Research Education (ICFRE) — which says that mining can be allowed in the area and will not adversely impact the flora fauna, forest cover and the lives of tribal community in the area. However, in 2017 when the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) granted prospecting licence for the operation of Kente Extension mines, it put the condition that the forest clearance related decision should be taken on the basis of the biodiversity and impact report filed by ICFRE and Wildlife Institute of India (WII).
