Cleansing notice under Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act (Cth)

Amaero International Limited ("the Company") (ASX:3DA) issued 513,948 fully paid Ordinary Shares (Shares) on 1 August 2022 after receipt of FIRB approval. This completes the Placement as ratified by Shareholders on 23 June 2022.
