Joining NVIDIA GDN will help Pentanet expand its compute capabilities beyond just GeForce NOW cloud gaming (GFN) and enable the Company to take advantage of additional industrial and commercial opportunities with its NVIDIA cloud infrastructure.

The NVIDIA L40 graphics processing unit (GPU), powered by the NVIDIA Ada Lovelace architecture, delivers revolutionary neural graphics, virtualisation, and compute capabilities for GPU-accelerated data centre workloads. Its third-generation RT Cores and industry-leading 48 GB of GDDR6 memory deliver up to twice the real-time ray-tracing performance of the previous generation to accelerate high-fidelity creative workflows, including real-time, full-fidelity, interactive rendering, 3D design, video streaming, and virtual production.
