WILLS CREEK NICKEL EXPLORATION CRANKS UP

Navigator Resources Limited (Navigator) has commenced a 600m reverse circulation (RC) drill programme to test the Palamino and Sparrow nickel prospects within the company's 100%-owned Wills Creek project in the East Kimberley.

The 215 square kilometre Wills Creek project is located 15 kilometres south of the Sally Malay nickel mine, and 2 kilometres along strike from the Copernicus nickel deposit, where mining is planned subject to a positive feasibility study.

The current Wills Creek drill programme will test a combination of ground electromagnetic (EM) targets, outcropping nickel mineralisation, and strike extensions to narrow (4cm) massive sulphide mineralisation encountered by a previous explorer in the early 1980's.

Navigator completed an 80 square kilometre airborne EM survey at Wills Creek last week with results currently being processed.

A larger RC drill programme is planned at Wills Creek in late August/early September to test results from the latest airborne EM survey, to follow up on results from the current RC drill programme, and to test recently identified targets including a nickel-copper-PGM exposure located 3-4 kilometres along strike to the north of Palamino (ASX release 17 June 2004).

In relation to the Company's other East Kimberley projects, RC drilling is planned to commence at the 290 square kilometre Laura River gold project in approximately 4 weeks. The drilling programme will test a number of targets found on virgin ground including "The Rack" prospect where selected non-representative rock chip sampling has returned peak grades of 56g/t Au, 115g/t Au, 26g/t Au and 54g/t Au (ASX release 17 June 2004). The Laura River project is located 3 kilometres north of Terra Gold's gold treatment plant on the Nicholson's Find goldfield.

A ground EM survey is scheduled to commence in approximately two weeks covering Navigator's Eastman VMS prospect, where RC drilling in late 2003 returned an intercept of 12m at 5.69 % zinc, 1.86 % lead, 3.20 % copper, 26.50 g/t silver and 0.41 g/t gold.
