EVANS & TATE LIMITED – NSW SUPREME COURT DECISION

The NSW Supreme Court has this morning dismissed as a abuse of process the application by Australian Beverage Distributors Pty Ltd (ABD) to wind up Evans & Tate Limited (ASX: ETW) (Evans & Tate) and Evans & Tate Premium Wines Pty Ltd (ETPW).

The main orders in the decision by Mr. Justice White were:

- the Originating Process filed by ABD for the winding up of Evans & Tate and ETPW be summarily dismissed as an abuse of process;
- ABD be restrained from commencing any further winding up proceedings against Evans & Tate and ETPW based on the same alleged debt;
- ABD pay Evans & Tate's and ETPW's legal costs on an indemnity basis in the winding up proceedings; and
- the previous costs order in favour of ABD, which was the subject of the winding up proceedings, be stayed pending finalisation of the litigation between the parties in the Newcastle District Court.

ABD had also sought a declaration that the Notice of Meeting of Noteholders of Evans & Tate's Unsecured Convertible Notes (ASX: ETWG), scheduled to be held on 14 June 2006, is false and misleading, but this was withdrawn from their application before the court hearing commenced last Thursday.

The court has delivered today's judgement verbally, and written reasons for the decision will be released by Evans & Tate when made available by the court.
