Competent Persons Statement

China Yunnan Copper Australia Ltd advises that in relation to the half year report lodged with ASX yesterday the company omitted to include a competent persons statement in relation to the following extract from the Review of Operations on page 4 of the accounts which read as follows:

Pentland

Drilling at the Toomba Prospect was undertaken during the period. The Toomba prospect has extensive historic workings and traces of mineralisation over an area of 1.5 kilometres by 1 kilometre. Results of drilling were released to the ASX on the 5th of January. Results highlights included 4 metres at 13.9 g/t gold from 43m, PC005 (including 1 meter at 50.59g/t gold, 0.5% copper, 1.5% lead and 3.3 % zinc).

These early drill results will be extended at depth to test a link between structural mineralisation intercepted to date and potential high tonnage intrusive mineralisation at depth with a track mounted diamond drill rig to be contracted for follow up drilling in 2009.

In relation to the above extract the following statement is applicable.

Competent Persons Statement

The information in this report that relates to Exploration Results is based on information compiled by Jason Beckton, who is a Member of the Australian Institute of Geoscientists and a Member of the Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy, and is the Managing Director of China Yunnan Copper Australia Ltd. Mr Beckton has sufficient experience relevant to the styles of mineralisation and type of deposits under consideration and to the activity he is undertaking to qualify as a Competent Person as defined in the 2004 Edition of the "Australasian Code for Reporting of Exploration Results and Mineral Resources. ". Mr Beckton consents to the inclusion in the report of the matters based on his information in the form and context in which it appears.
