COMPLETION OF DIESEL TEST AUSTRALIA ACQUISITION

Allomak Limited (ASX:AMA) today announced the completion of the Diesel Test Australia acquisition. This acquisition was first announced to the market on 21 December 2006, as of today all due diligence and board approval has been completed.

The acquisition payment involves upfront and deferred cash and equity components which are subject to performance. For on target performance, the equity components would represent an initial component of \$75,000 payable in shares, and up to approximately \$669,100 in further shares divided between 6 months and 12 months at the 10 day VWAP price at the time of issue.

Mr Steve Brown, the CEO of Diesel Test said, "We welcome the chance, with the added resources of Allomak, to expand and capture the full potential of our business."

Chief Executive Officer of Allomak, Mr Rob Allan said, "We are very pleased to welcome Diesel Test as part of Allomak as it is a good company with an experienced management team, and is also a good fit with our existing businesses."
