As part of the strategic partnership, archTIS's next generation of secure information sharing and collaboration cloud services, Kojensi Gov, will be hosted on Vault's ASD certified cloud. Vault is one of only six organisations to achieve 'PROTECTED' certification on the Government's Australian Signals Directorate's (ASD) Certified Cloud Services List. 'PROTECTED' is a security classification that requires information marked as such to be handled under certain security controls that are regulated by Government. Most commercial offerings do not meet these standards.

The combination of this highly secure cloud with Kojensi Gov offers a sovereign, proven and unique capability in secure information sharing and collaboration for Australian governments and their industry partners.

The strategic partnership also includes the opportunity to jointly accelerate market awareness and sales of the Kojensi products and services via Vault's national partner ecosystem of Government Departments and critical infrastructure entities.

archTIS will launch its beta version of Kojensi Gov on the Vault Cloud in Q4 2018. This will be followed by more in-depth testing with Federal Government agencies and a commercial market launch in early 2019.

While the strategic partnership is not expected to have any direct financial benefit to the Company in terms of payments from Vault, the value of the strategic partnership, the combination and cross promotion of the two companies and the use of Vault's cloud services as a critical part of the Kojensi products is expected to have longer term benefits for the Company.
