Exploration Access Granted on Reserves in Ajana Project Area

Anson Resources Limited (ASX: ASN) (Anson or the Company) is pleased to announce that the Department of Mines and Petroleum (DMP) and associated government departments have granted access for Anson to carry out exploration activities on the Water for Travellers Reserve (1474) and the Excepted from Sale Reserve (14606) (the Reserves) at Anson's wholly owned Ajana Graphite Project. These areas include graphitic target zones (conductors) identified by the recently completed Versatile Time Domain Electromagnetic (VTEM) Survey and numerous historic prospects.

Anson has also signed land access agreements with the land owners that the tenements E66/89 and E66/94 overlay. The freehold land has now been included into the grant of these tenements.

In addition there are 6 Queen Victoria Crown Ground (QVCG) freehold blocks which are overlain by tenement E66/89. The QVCG's were awarded to private landholders prior to the forming of the State of Western Australia. Hence, the West Australian Government does not hold the mineral rights to the QVCG's nor is the Government permitted to grant exploration licences over the land. Native Title does not apply to QVCG's. Thus this project represents the first opportunity for modern day exploration over this well-endowed region.

Anson has completed the research on the mineral rights and ownership of QVCG5 in the Walcott Prospect area and signed a land access agreement with the land owner. As a result exploration activities will not be restricted.

Research on the other QVCG blocks, which only covers a small area of the tenement, will be carried out prior to future exploration programs being planned for those areas.

The Reserves and the QVCG's in the Ajana Project area contain a number of historic copper, lead and silver producing mines that date back to 1850.

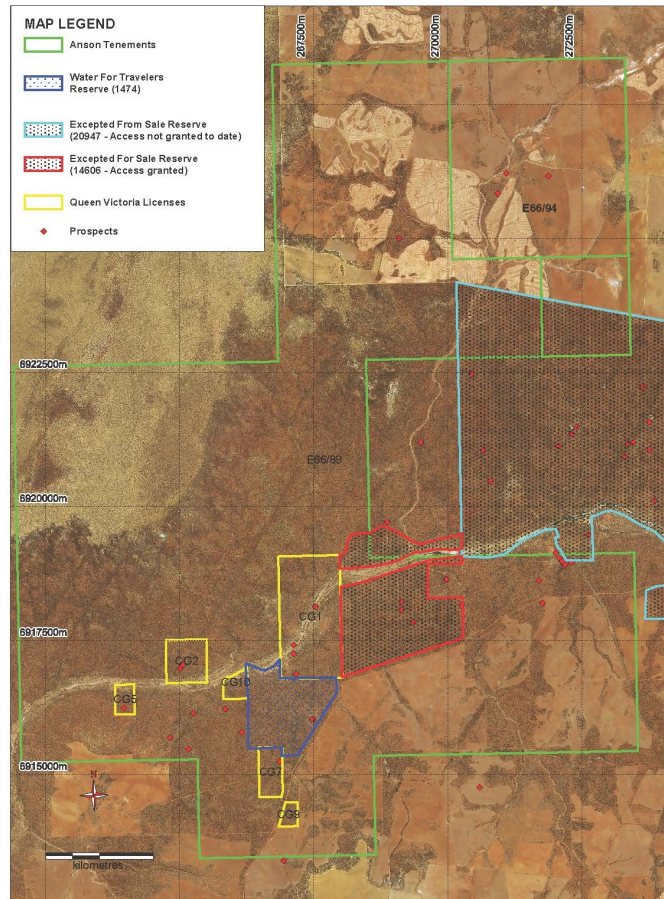


Figure 1: Plan showing Anson tenements and the additional areas to which access has been granted

Figure 1 shows the tenements and the additional areas to which access has been granted.

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About the Ajana Graphite Project

Located in Western Australia, a proven and established mining province with a stable political environment, the Ajana graphite project is adjacent to the North West Coast Highway and 130km north of Geraldton.

The prospective ground on the 115km² of tenements E66/89 and E66/94 contains extensive areas of graphite schist mineralization within a Proterozoic gneissic geology. The Ajana area is dominated by the Proterozoic gneiss with conformable lenses of meta-sediment, pelitic gneiss, meta-quartzite, mafic gneiss and graphitic schist known as the Northampton Metamorphic Complex. This gneissic geological environment, typically hosts high grade graphite deposits in Western Australia and graphite deposits worldwide.

The information in this announcement that relates to exploration results and geology is based on information compiled and/or reviewed by Mr Greg Knox, a member in good standing of the Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy.
