2.1 Details of financing and investing transactions which have had a material effect on consolidated assets and liabilities but did not involve cash flows

During the quarter the company acquired, pursuant to takeover offer, the remaining 49% interest in Australian Uranium Ltd, the consideration being the issue of 39,200,000 ordinary fully paid shares and 39,200,000 options. The deemed value of the consideration paid was \$29,008,000.

During the previous quarter, the company acquired the Gabanintha and Nowthanna Projects from its parent entity, Greater Pacific Gold Limited. The consideration included the issue of 40,000,000 ordinary fully paid shares and 20,000,000 options at a deemed consideration of \$8,000,000 and \$805,000 respectively. The acquisition was in accordance with the Prospectus dated 13 December 2006.
