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COMPLETION OF AIRBORNE SURVEY – TURNER’S DOME, NT

Yellow Rock Resources Ltd is pleased to announce that the airborne survey on the Turner’s Dome tenement, which was conducted by GPX Airborne Services Pty Ltd, has now been completed.

Turner’s Dome is a granted tenement (EL25426) situated 340 kilometres north-west of Alice Springs, NT and located in the Arunta Uranium Region.

EL25426 is 1,590 square kilometres in area and the southern boundary is less than two kilometres north of the Bigrlyi uranium and vanadium deposit.

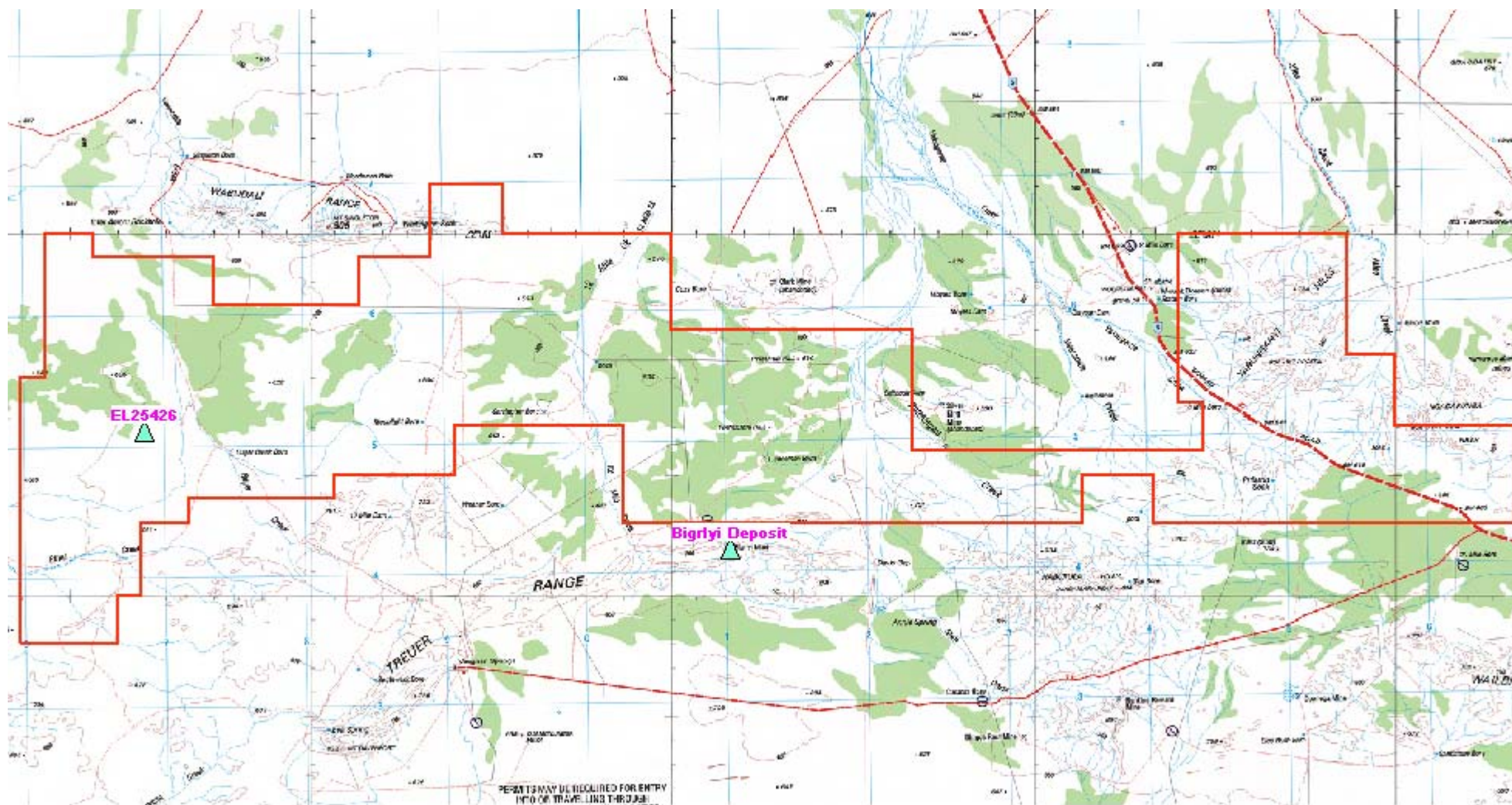
The controlling entity of Bigrlyi, Energy Metals Ltd (ASX: EME) has reported an indicated and inferred JORC standard resource containing 23.4 million lbs of uranium and 43.7 million lbs of vanadium.

The Radiometrics and TMI Magnetic fixed-wing airborne survey was conducted on the section north of Bigrlyi and east towards the Tanami Road. The airborne survey was conducted at 100 metre line spacings, for 3,318 line kilometres, approximately 60 metres off the ground.

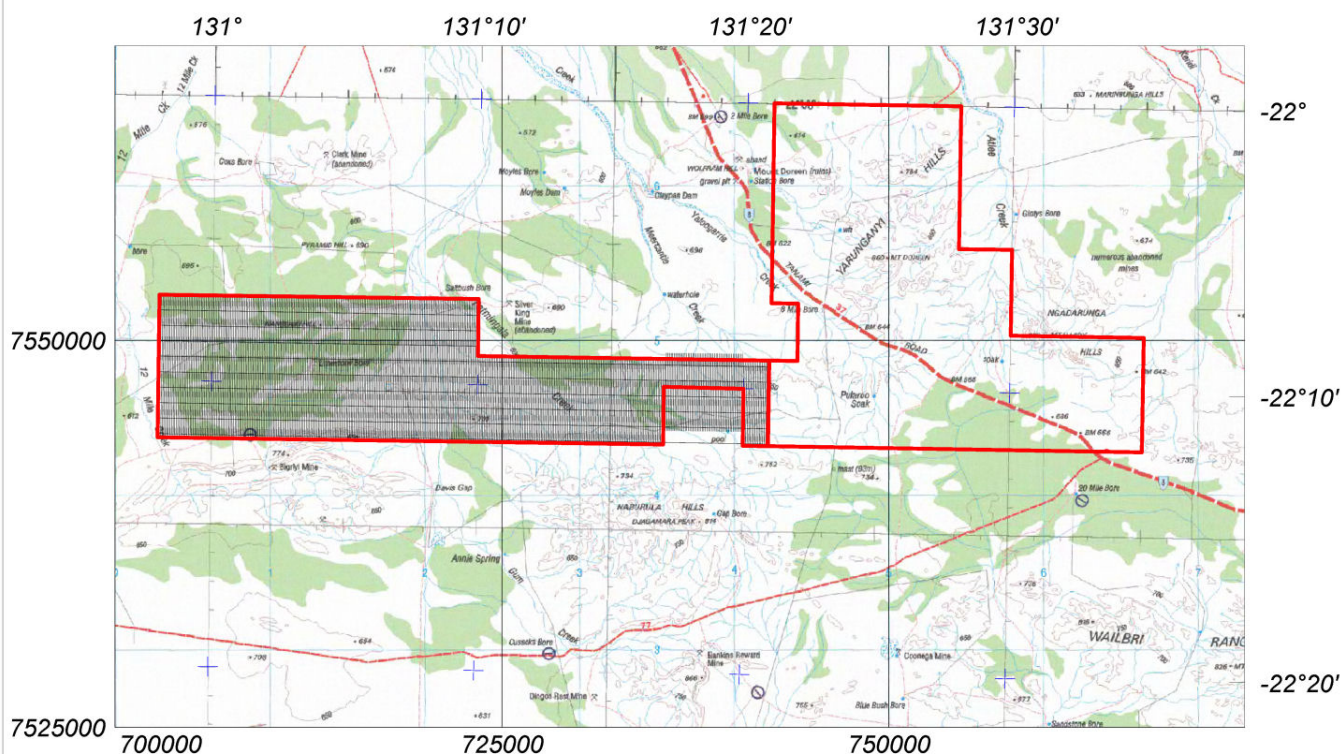
The airborne survey will assist the company in locating uranium anomalies and identifying the drainage patterns of the areas.

An independent geologist, Mr Brian Davis, is now processing the data and the company awaits his findings and commentary. As soon as the company is aware of the results, they will be released to the market.
