BUSINESS OF THE MEETING

The resolutions are ordinary resolutions. An ordinary resolution will be passed if approved by at least 50% of the votes cast by members entitled to vote on the resolution.

The business of the Meeting is as follows:

1 ANNUAL ACCOUNTS

To receive and consider the reports of the Directors and the Auditors, the Statement of Financial Performance, Statement of Financial Position, and the Statement of Cash Flows for the year ended 30 June 2021.



2 RESOLUTION 1 - REMUNERATION REPORT

To receive and consider the Remuneration Report for the year ended 30 June 2021 in accordance with Section 250R(2) of the Corporations Act 2001 and if thought fit to pass, with or without amendment, the following Ordinary Resolution:

“That the Remuneration Report and the amounts paid to the Directors and Officers of the Company as set out in the Directors’ report be adopted”.

3. RESOLUTION 2 – RE-ELECTION DIRECTOR

To consider, and if thought fit, to pass the following as an ordinary resolution:

“**THAT** for the purposes of Rule 8.6 of the Company’s constitution and for all other purposes, Mr Ronald Phillips AO, who retires in accordance with Rule 8.6(a) of the Company’s constitution and being eligible for re-election, is re-elected as a director of the Company, with effect on and from the date of this resolution.”

QUORUM FOR THE MEETING

The quorum for the Meeting is the lesser (by number) of:

- (a) five members present in person; or
- (b) members present in person representing at least 10% of the voting shares.

RESOLUTION	PERSONS EXCLUDED FROM VOTING
1. Remuneration Report	A vote on this Resolution must not be cast (in any capacity) by or on behalf of either of the following persons: (a) a member of the Key Management Personnel¹, details of whose remuneration are included in the Remuneration Report; or (b) a Closely Related Party of such a member. However, a person (the voter) described above may cast a vote on this Resolution as a proxy if the vote is not cast on behalf of a person described above and either: (a) the voter is appointed as a proxy by writing that specifies the way the proxy is to vote on this Resolution; or (b) the voter is the Chair and the appointment of the Chair as proxy: (i) does not specify the way the proxy is to vote on this Resolution; and (ii) expressly authorises the Chair to exercise the proxy even though this Resolution is connected directly or indirectly with the remuneration of a member of the Key Management Personnel. However, the above prohibition does not apply if: (a) the proxy is the Chair; and (b) the appointment expressly authorises the Chair to exercise the proxy even though this Resolution is connected directly or indirectly with remuneration of a member of the Key Management Personnel.

¹A closely related party of a member of the Key Management Personnel means any of the following:

- a spouse, child or dependent of the member;
- a child or dependent of the member's spouse;
- anyone else who is one of the member's family and may be expected to influence, or be influenced by, the member in the member's dealings with the Company;
- a company the member controls; or
- a person prescribed by regulations (as at the date of this notice of meeting, no additional persons have been prescribed by regulation).

Determination of Membership and Voting Entitlement

For the purpose of determining a person's entitlement to vote at the Meeting, a person will be recognised as a Shareholder and the holder of Shares if that person is registered as a holder of those Shares at 7pm (Sydney Time) on 20 November 2021.

How to Vote

Due to the continuing developments in relation to the COVID-19 situation, related restrictions on public gatherings and public health concerns the Meeting will be held as a virtual meeting. Changes to the Corporations Act provide for the holding of a virtual meeting provided it gives all Shareholders a reasonable opportunity to participate without being physically present in the same place.

Upon a poll, every person who has lodged a proxy, or who is present in person via audio conference or by proxy, corporate representative or attorney will have one vote for each Share held by that person.

(b) Voting by proxy

A Shareholder entitled to attend and vote is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote instead of the Shareholder by completing, signing and returning the enclosed Proxy Form by the time and in accordance with the instructions set out in the Proxy Form.

Proxies will not be able to physically attend the Meeting. Accordingly, Shareholders entitled to vote are encouraged to appoint the Chair as their proxy for this Meeting.

To be effective, Proxy Forms must be received by the Company by no later than 4pm (Sydney Time) on Saturday, 20 November 2021.

In light of the substantial delays in postage times as a result of the COVID-19 virus, Proxy Forms that are posted may not be received by the Company in time for the Meeting.

A proxy form submitted via email must be signed by the Shareholder or his or her attorney who has not received any notice of revocation of the authority. Proxies given by corporations must be signed in accordance with corporation's constitution and Corporations Act.



Shareholders can direct their proxy to vote for, against, or to abstain from voting on, a resolution by marking the appropriate box in the enclosed Proxy Form.

Where the boxes 'for', 'against' or 'abstain' opposite the items for resolutions are not completed, this will be deemed an express authorisation for the person appointed as proxy to exercise the proxy as they see fit.

The Chair intends to vote all undirected and available proxies in favour of each item of business, subject to any voting exclusions that apply to the proxy. Shareholders will be informed of the proxy position at the meeting.

(c) Voting by corporate representative

Any corporate shareholder who has appointed a person to act as its corporate representative at the Meeting should provide that person with a certificate or letter executed in accordance with the Corporations Act authorising him or her to act as that company's representative. The authority must be emailed to info@bcaldiagnostics.com, with the corporate shareholder's request to register for the Meeting.

(d) Voting by attorney

A Shareholder entitled to vote at the Meeting is entitled to appoint an attorney to join and vote at the Meeting on the Shareholder's behalf.

An attorney need not be a holder of Shares.



Explanatory Statement

1 GENERAL

This Explanatory Statement has been prepared for the information of Shareholders in connection with the business specified to be conducted at the Annual General Meeting to be held on 22 November 2021 at 4 pm (Sydney Time).

The Directors recommend that Shareholders read this Explanatory Memorandum in full in conjunction with the accompanying Notice of which this Explanatory Memorandum forms a part.

Annual Report

As required under Section 317 of the Corporations Act, the annual financial report (which includes the financial statements and Directors' declarations) for the year ended 30 June 2021 will be tabled at the Annual General Meeting.

The Company will not provide a hard copy of the annual financial report to Shareholders unless specifically requested to do so. An electronic copy of the annual financial report is available on the Company's website: www.bcaldiagnostics.com

While no resolution is required in relation to this item, Shareholders will be given the opportunity to ask questions and make comments on the financial statements and reports. The Company's auditor, Pitcher Partners, will be present at the Meeting and Shareholders will have an opportunity to ask the auditor questions in relation to the conduct of the audit, the auditor's report, the Company's accounting policies and the independence of the auditor.

RESOLUTION 1 – NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS REMUNERATION

The Corporations Act requires that at a listed company's Annual General Meeting, a resolution that the remuneration report be adopted must be put to the shareholders. However, such a resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.

If at least 25% of the votes cast on Resolution 1 are voted against adoption of the Remuneration Report at the Annual General Meeting, and then again at the Company's 2022 Annual General Meeting, the Company will be required to put to Shareholders a resolution proposing the calling of a general meeting to consider the appointment of directors of the Company (**Spill Resolution**).

If more than 50% of Shareholders vote in favour of the Spill Resolution, the Company must convene the general meeting (**Spill Meeting**) within 90 days of the Company's 2022 Annual General Meeting. All of the Directors who were in office when the Company's 2022 Directors' report was approved, other than the managing director of the Company, will cease to hold office immediately before the end of the Spill Meeting but may stand for re-election at the Spill Meeting. Following the Spill Meeting those persons whose election or re-election as Directors is approved will be the Directors of the Company.

The remuneration report sets out the Company's remuneration arrangements for the Directors and senior management of the Company. The remuneration report is part of the Directors' report contained in the annual financial report of the Company for the financial year ending 30 June 2021.

A reasonable opportunity will be provided for discussion of the remuneration report at the Annual General Meeting.



Proxy Restrictions

If the Chairman of the Meeting is your proxy (or he becomes your proxy by default), you will be taken to have expressly authorised him to exercise your proxy in relation to resolution 1 (Adoption of the Remuneration Report) even though the Chairman is, and those items are, connected directly or indirectly with the remuneration of a member of the key management personnel of the BCAL Diagnostics Limited. Shareholders will be informed of the proxy position and the manner in which the Chairman intends to vote undirected proxies at the meeting.

Definitions

Key Management Personnel has the same meaning as in the accounting standards and broadly includes those persons having authority and responsibility for planning, directing and controlling the activities of the Company, directly or indirectly, including any director (whether executive or otherwise) of the Company.

Closely Related Party of a member of the Key Management Personnel means:

- (a) a spouse or child of the member;
- (b) a child of the member's spouse;
- (c) a dependent of the member or the member's spouse;
- (d) anyone else who is one of the member's family and may be expected to influence the member, or be influenced by the member, in the member's dealing with the entity;
- (e) a company the member controls; or
- (f) a person prescribed by the *Corporations Regulations 2001 (Cth)*.

Remuneration Report means the remuneration report set out in the Director's report section of the Company's annual financial report for the year ended 30 June 2021.

Directors' Recommendation

Noting that each Director has a personal interest in their own remuneration from the Company as set out in the Remuneration Report, the Board recommends that Shareholders vote in favour of this resolution.



2 RESOLUTION 2 – RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTOR

(a) Background

Pursuant to clause 8.6(a) of the Company's Constitution, Mr Ronald Phillips AO retires at the 2021 Annual General Meeting but, being eligible, offers himself for re-election.

(b) A brief profile of Mr Ronald Phillips (AO) is set out in the Annual Report of the Company.

(c) Directors' Recommendation

The Board (other than Mr Ronald Phillips) recommends that Shareholders vote in favour of this resolution.
