Request for Voluntary Suspension

Black Rock Mining Limited ("Company") (ASX:BKT) In accordance with the requirements of Listing Rule 17.2, Black Rock Mining hereby requests that the company's securities be placed in voluntary suspension (BKT and BKTOD) , pending an announcement regarding the draft changes to mining legislation proposed by the Tanzanian Government. The proposed changes and impact on the company's Mahenge Graphite project are ongoing and yet to be fully ascertained.

Further to our request on 3 July 2017 to be placed in a trading halt, the Company is awaiting further guidance from its advisors and the pending release of the new mining code and mining regulations before being able to provide shareholders and the market with a further update. Therefore a voluntary suspension is requested until an announcement is made to the market expected to be on or before Monday 10 July 2017.

The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted.
