Murrin Murrin licences surrendered

Boadicea Resources has surrendered its mining and prospecting licences comprising the Murrin Murrin project at Leonora in Western Australia.

As a result of a recent field trip to investigate anomalies from previous soil sampling it has been determined that the licences are unlikely to have the potential to justify further expenditure.

Accordingly the funds which would have been spent at Murrin Murrin will be allocated to the Company's key project Symons Hill in the Fraser Range in Western Australia where the Company considers the potential to be far greater.
