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**About Classic Minerals**

Classic Minerals listed on the ASX in May 2013. After flying VTEM over the whole tenement in June it identified 18 conductors across the tenement. In December Classic announced the discovery of Mammoth, a new nickel-copper mineralized horizon, which represents a new target style of magmatic nickel-copper mineralisation on the Fraser range.

Mammoth sits on Classic Minerals' 100% owned Fraser range tenement E28/1904, 40km from Sirius resources' Nova and Bollinger discoveries. The tenement is 84sqkm and has a total of 19 EM conductors now highlighted for exploration.

Exploration is currently focused on a 6km conductive target hot zone running south west from Mammoth.
