

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 708A(5)(e) OF THE CORPORATIONS ACT

Further to a general meeting held 19 June 2026, Condor Energy Ltd (ASX: CND) (**Condor** or the **Company**) whereat all resolutions were carried, Condor has issued the following securities:

1. 140,127,490 Performance Shares pursuant to the Acquisition Agreement announcement on 9 April 2026 to acquire the 20% Jaguar Interest in the Peru TEA (**Acquisition**);
2. 66,176,471 Attaching Options being one (1) attaching option for every two (2) New Shares allocated under the Offer announced 4 May 2026 ("**Attaching Options**"). The Attaching Options will have an exercise price of A\$0.030 and expire 3-years from the date of issue.
3. 22,058,824 Lead Manager options. The Lead Manager options will have an exercise price of \$0.040 and expire on 3 February 2028 (**Lead Manager Options**).

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About the Tumbes Basin TEA

A Technical Evaluation Agreement (TEA) is an oil and gas contract that provides the holder with the exclusive right to negotiate a Licence Contract over the TEA area.

In August 2023 the Company, with its partner Jaguar Exploration, Inc. (Jaguar), entered into the 4,858km² TEA LXXXVI offshore Peru with Perupetro (Figure 1). The TEA area covers almost all of the Peruvian offshore Tumbes Basin in shallow to moderate water depths of between 50m and 1,500m.

The under-explored block is surrounded by multiple historic and currently producing oil and gas fields and contains the undeveloped shallow water Piedra Redonda gas field.

Condor is the 100% holder of the TEA.
