Oman Copper Project – Drilling Commenced

Highlights

- **Diamond drilling has commenced at Maqail South to be followed by Mahab 4 and Hira Kilab for metallurgical purposes**
- **Infill and extensional drilling to commence on completion**
- **Orientation drone supported magnetics survey completed over Hara Kilab. Results are currently being processed.**

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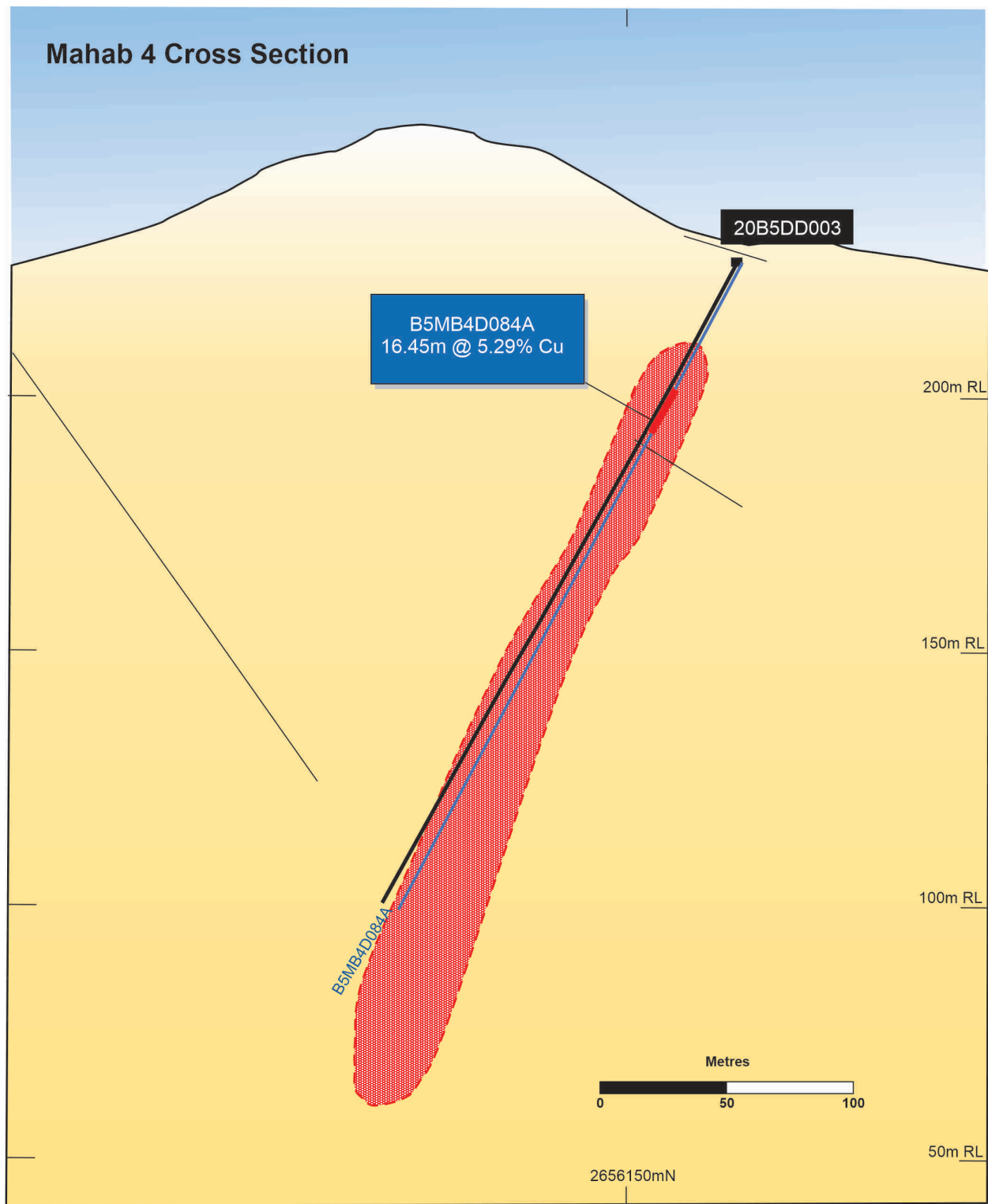


Figure 1: Cross Section Mahab 4 Proposed Drill Hole 20B5DD003. Orebody in red.

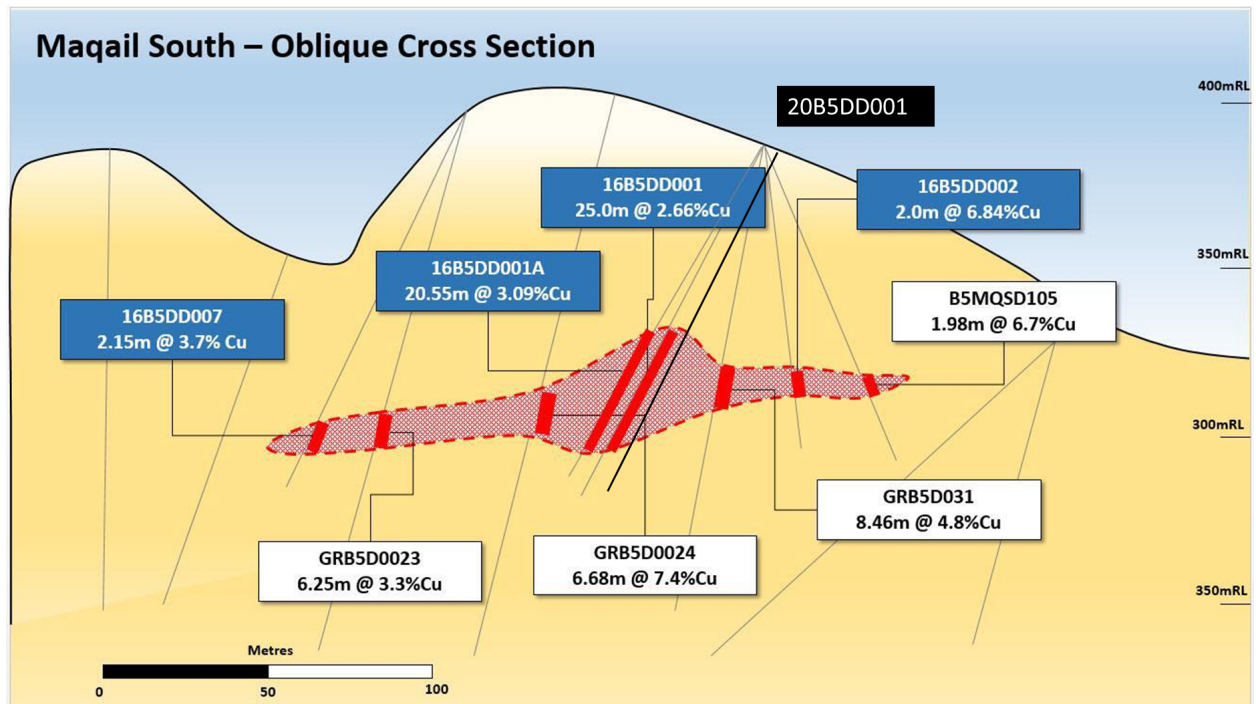


Figure 2: Cross Section Maqail South with Proposed Diamond Drill Hole 20B5DD001. Orebody in red.

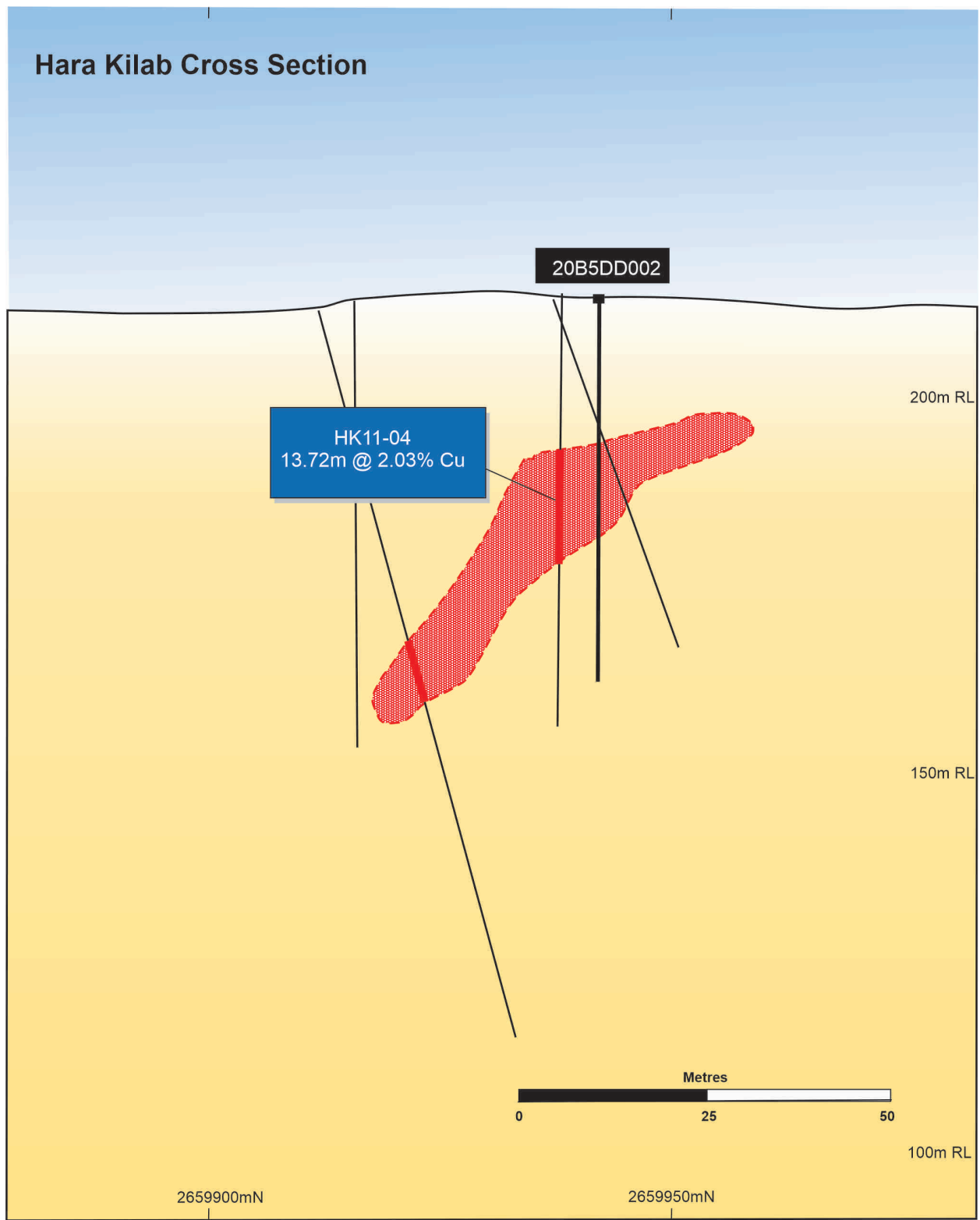


Figure 3: Cross Section Hara Kilab Proposed Hole 20B5DD002. Orebody in red.

Force Commodities Limited (ASX:4CE) (“Force” or the “Company”), is pleased to announce it has commenced drilling within Block 5 in the Sultanate of Oman. A single diamond drill hole into each of Mahab 4 (Figure 1), Maqail South (Figure 2) and Hara Kilab (Figure 3) will target the massive and disseminated copper sulphide zones within each orebody. The core obtained will be used for further metallurgical testing to support a scoping study currently underway.

This drilling (Figure 4) is expected to take approximately four weeks at which point the rig will be tasked with further infill and importantly, extensional drilling around each orebody. Mahab 4 is open to the north, Maqail South is open to the east and Hara Kilab is open to the west.

In addition to the drilling, a drone supported detailed magnetics survey over Hara Kilab (Figure 5) has been completed to determine the effectiveness of magnetics in defining mineralised massive and disseminated copper sulphide systems. The raw data collected will be processed over the next 2 weeks.

Simon Pooley, Force’s CEO commented: “We are very pleased to have been able to source a drill rig and commence drilling in the short time since completion of the Oman copper acquisition. As part of our stated strategy, the Company will complete the metallurgical and extensional drilling as soon as possible to support a scoping study that focuses on toll treatment as the preferred processing option.”
