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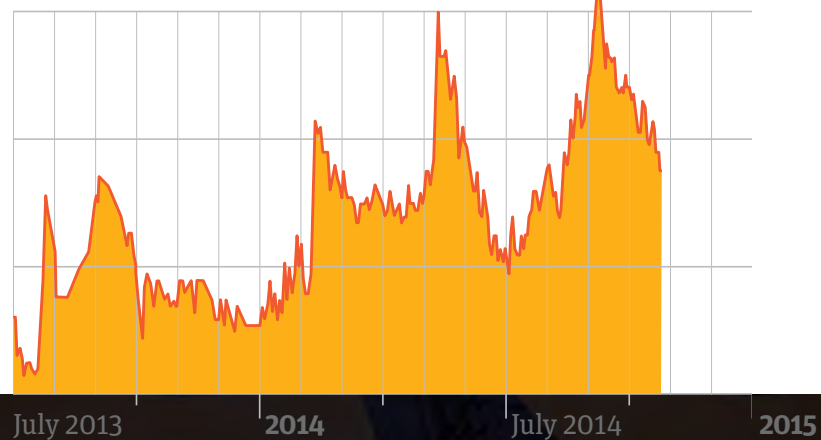

Core has 100% ownership of 20 tenements covering over 2,000km² - **Albarta Project, NT**

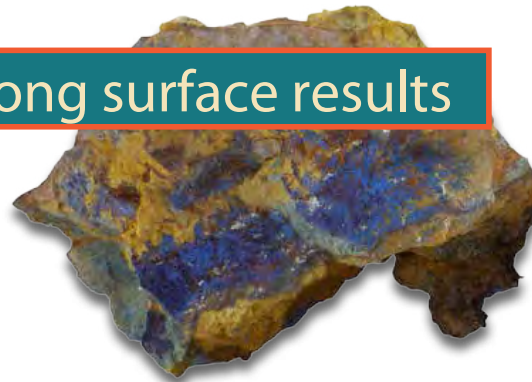

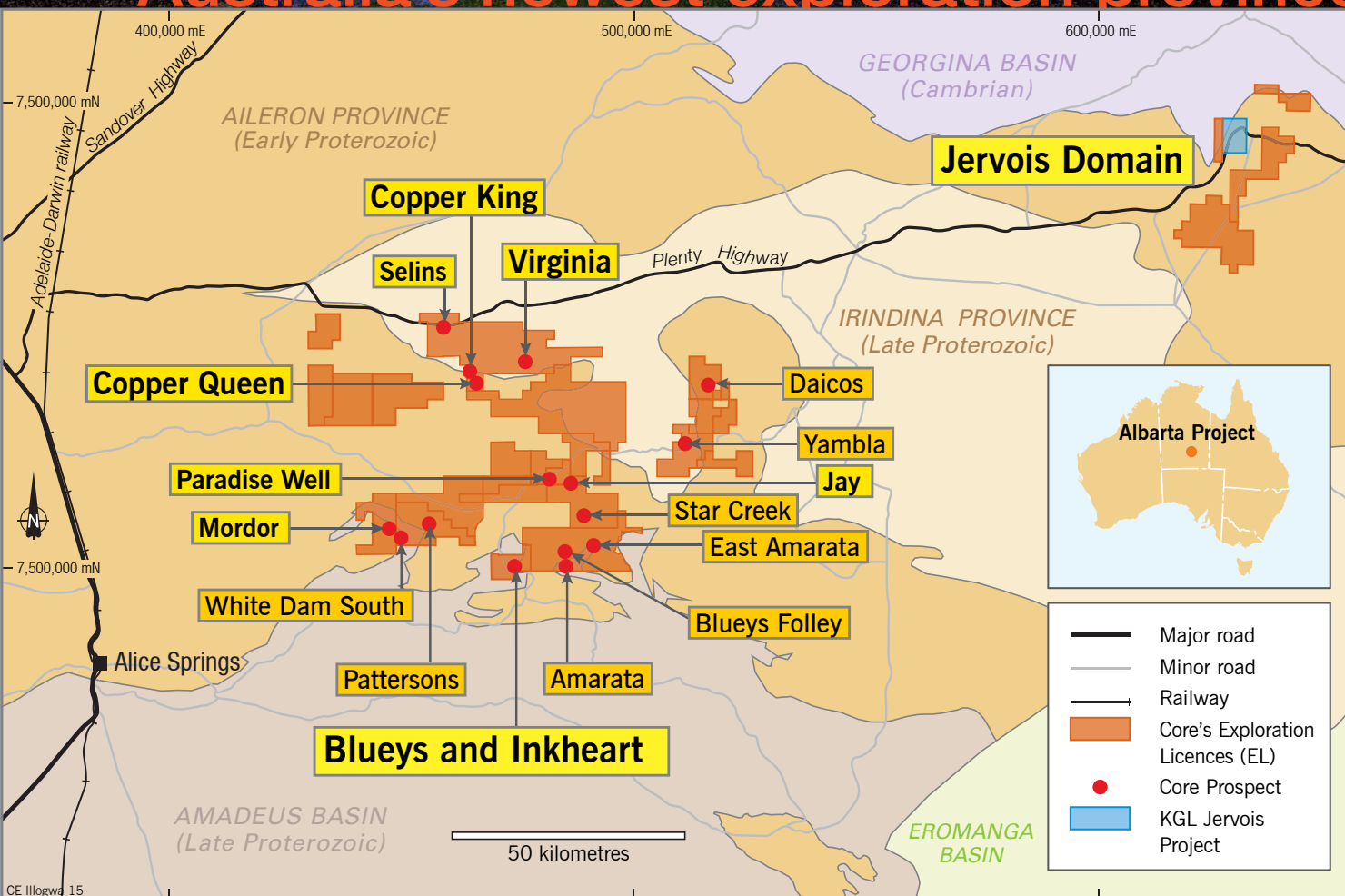

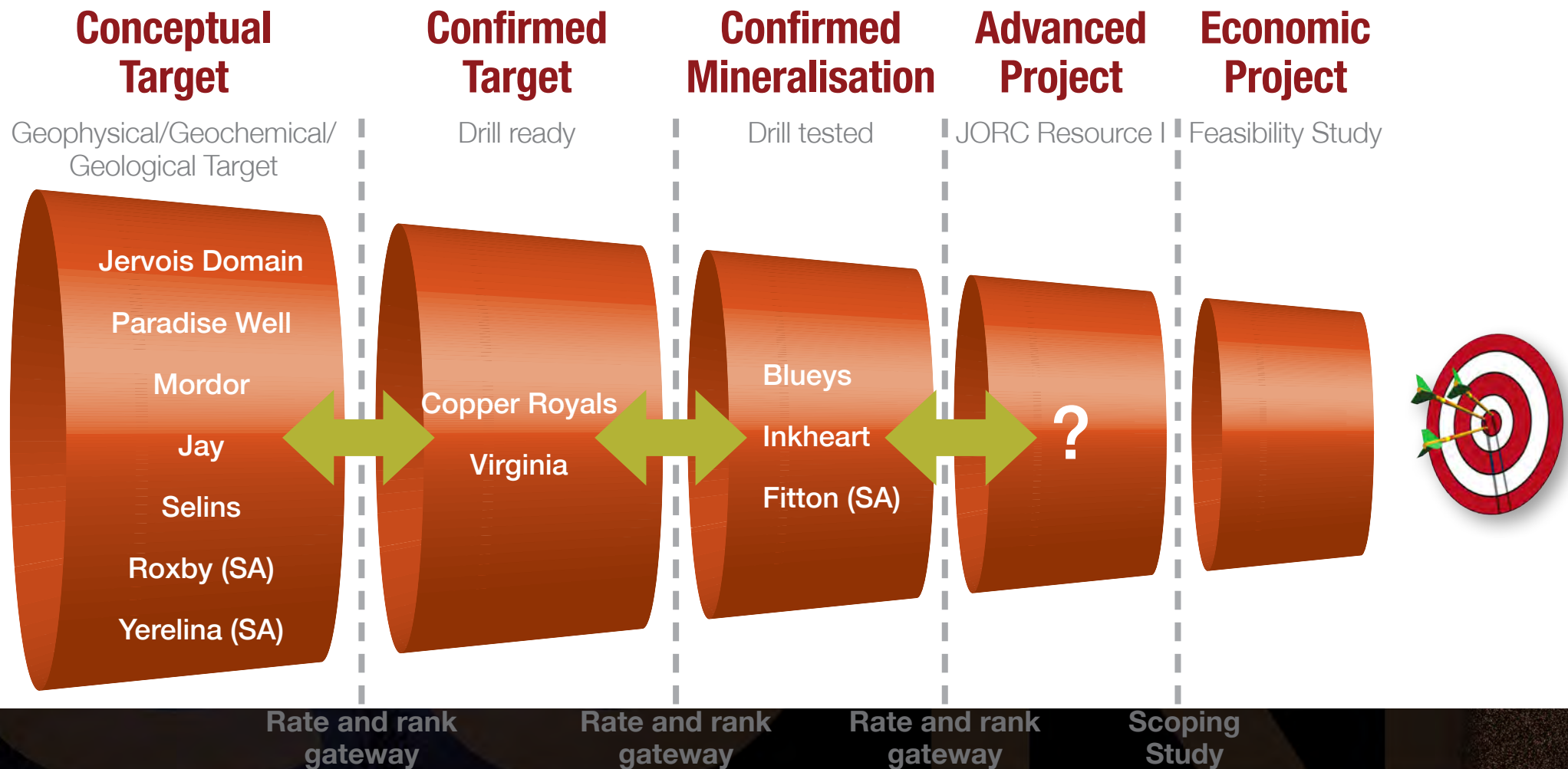

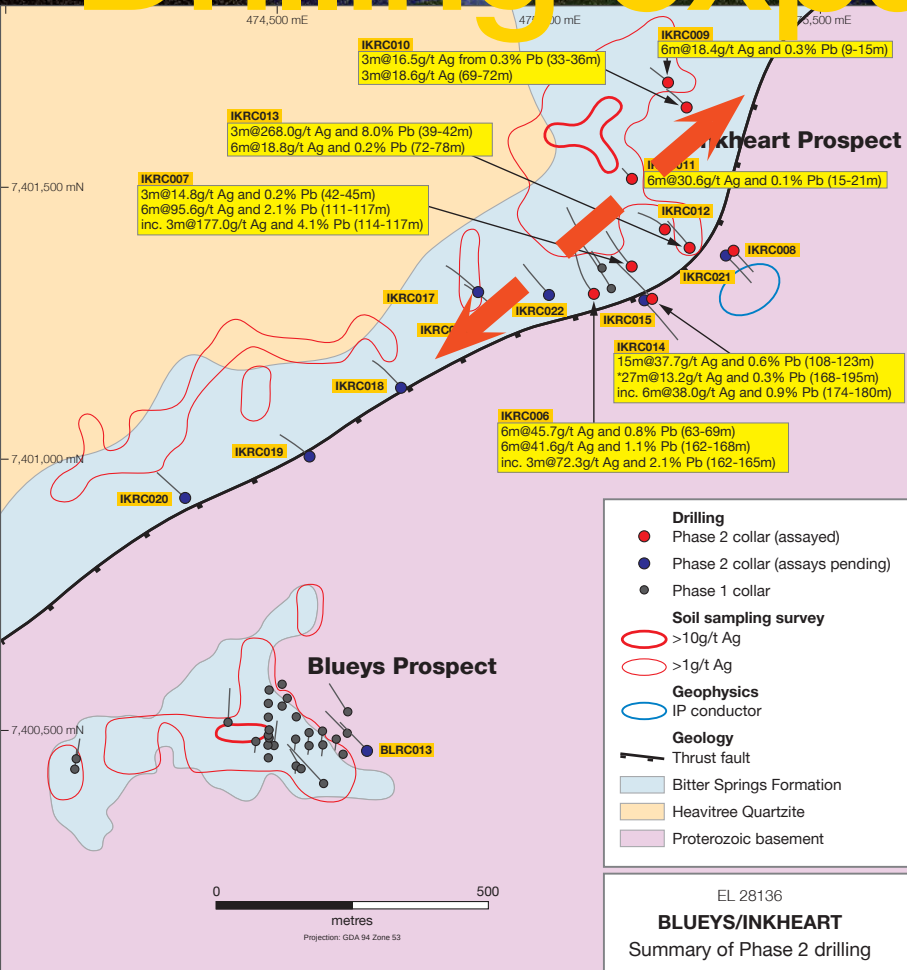
Very high grades of 4.5kg/t (4,500g/t) silver at surface

Discovery by Core at Inkheart in first drill program in the NT in May 2014

Drill intersections include:

- **1m @ 1,070g/t silver** (Ag) and **8% lead** (Pb) at **Blueys**
- **2m @ 843 g/t Ag** and **5.9% Pb** within 17m @ 116 g/t Ag and 0.83% Pb at **Blueys**
- **4m @ 195 g/t Ag, 5.24% Pb and 2.49% Zn** from 111m inc. 1m @ 354 g/t Ag, 11.13 % Pb and 6.51% Zn, within 36m @ 29g/t silver at **Inkheart**

Drilling expanding discovery



- First assay results received for Core's recent 2,500m RC drilling program
- Drilling is finding and extending silver-lead mineralised zones at Inkheart
- **3m @ 268.0g/t Ag & 8.0% Pb** [IKRC013 39-42m]
- **6m @ 95.6g/t Ag & 2.1% Pb** [IKRC007 111-117m]
inc. 3m @ 177.0g/t Ag & 4.1% Pb [114-117m]
- **15m @ 37.7g/t Ag & 0.6% Pb** [IKRC014 108-123m]
- Additional drill assays in next few days

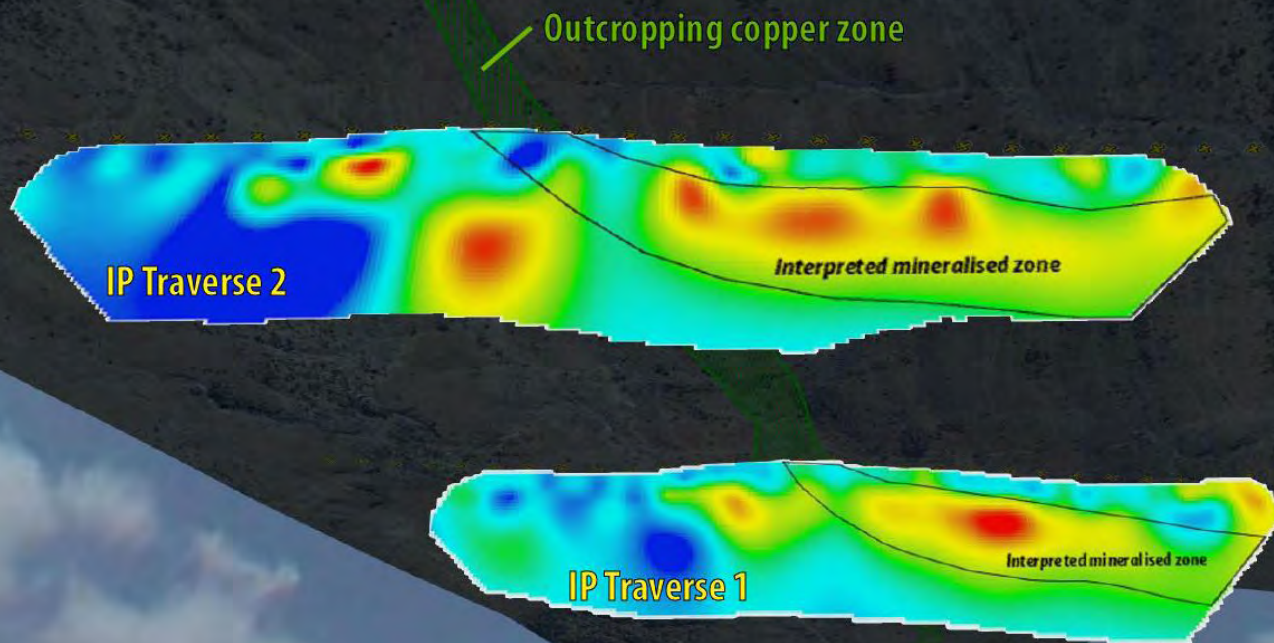

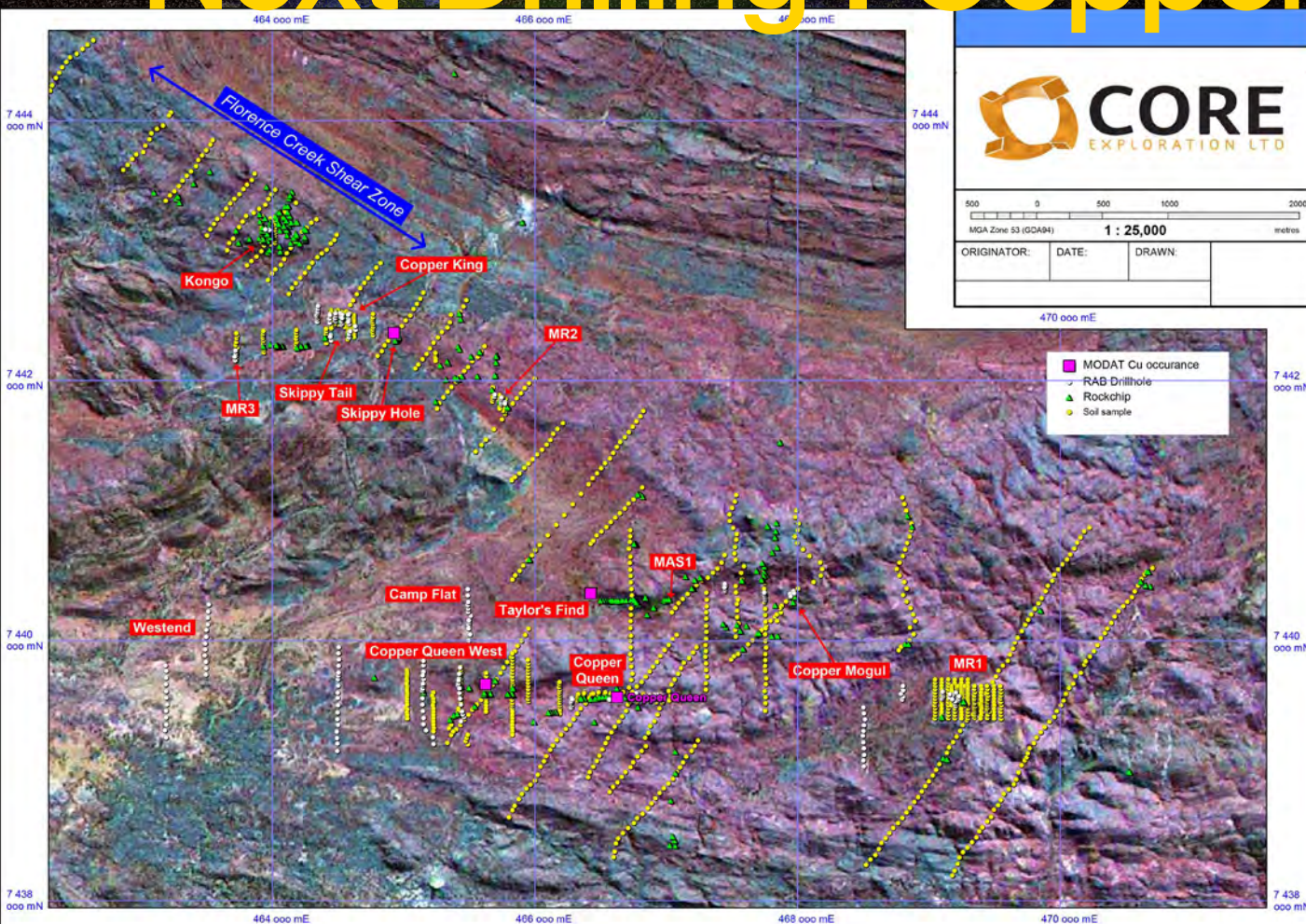

Next Drilling : Copper targets

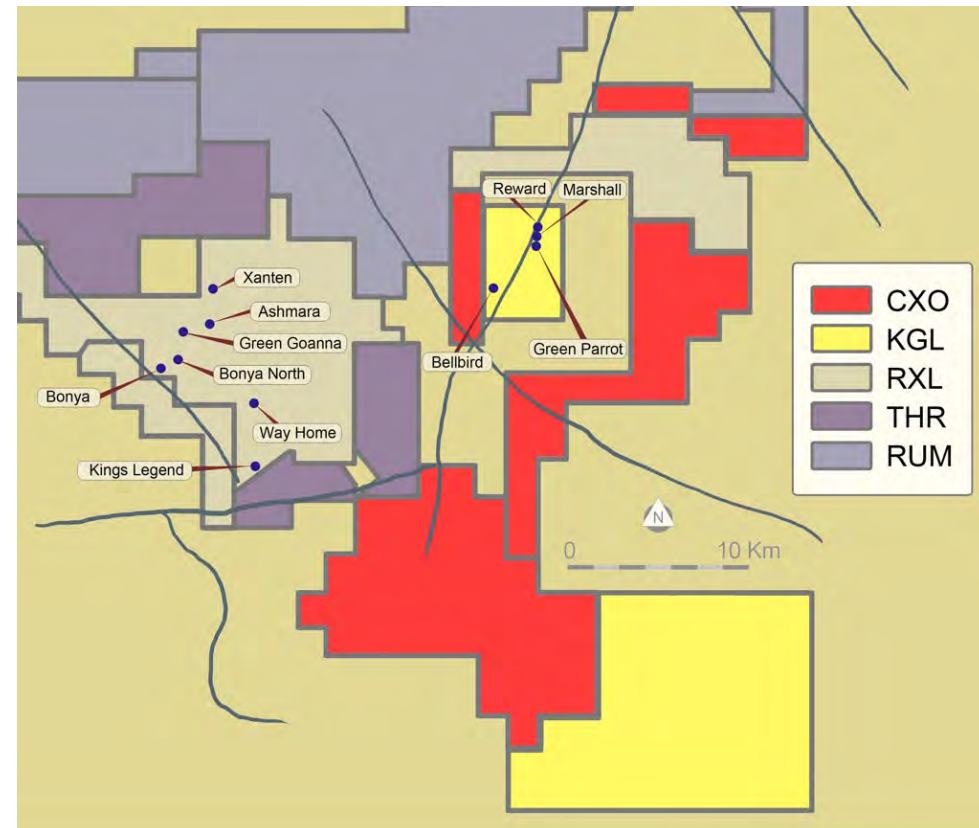


- District comprises 14 copper prospects

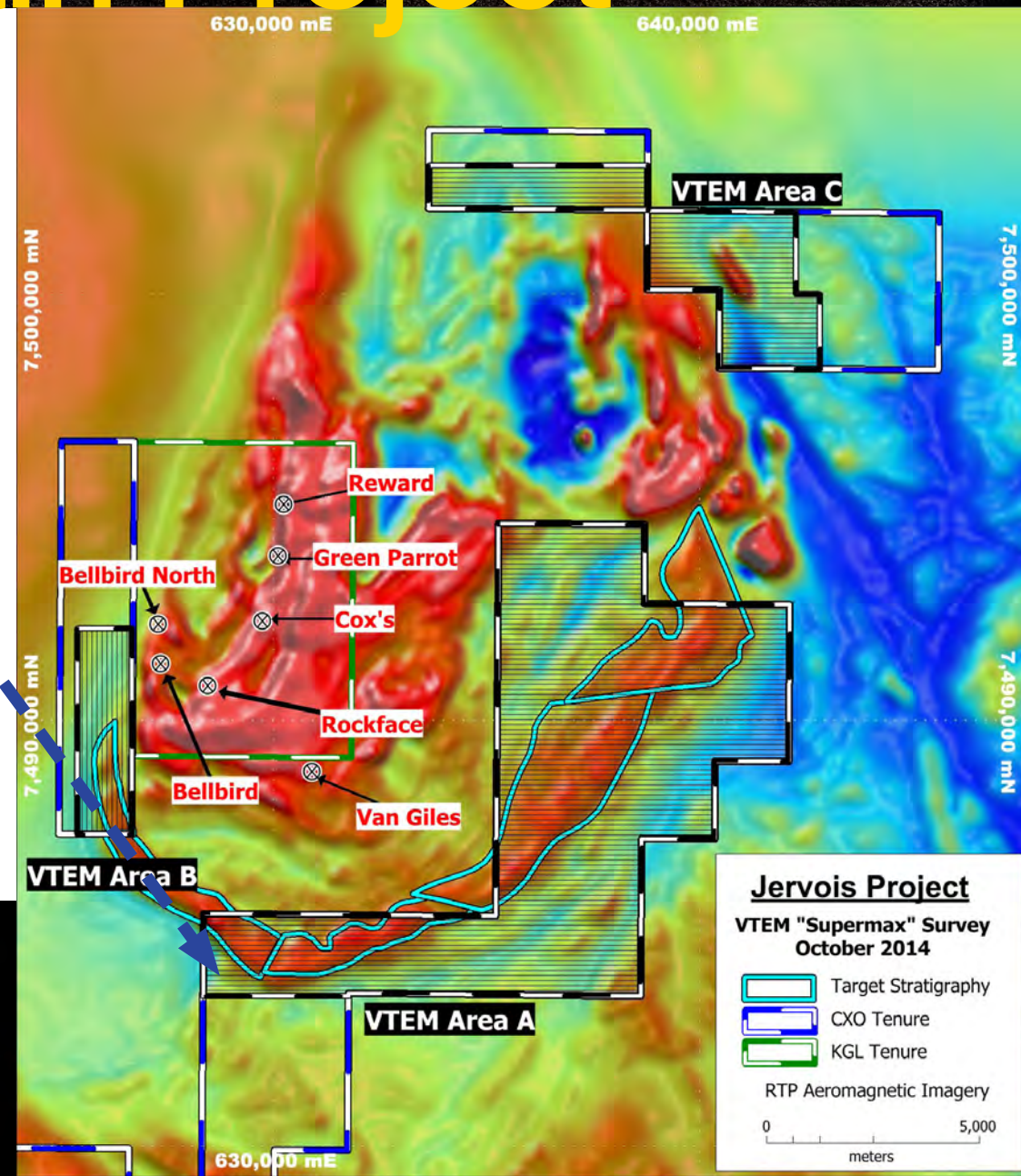

Catalysts for price growth

Core has full ownership of over 2,000km² in Australia's newest exploration province in the NT:

- Core is opening up a new exciting exploration province and entering into the discovery phase of exploration
- Multiple drilling programs : new drill results pending from Inkheart and Blueys to be followed by drilling of copper targets at Virginia and Copper Royals Q4 2014
- Jervois Domain AEM surveys results are pending - to define copper targets to drill Q1 2015
- NT drilling to start again in November
