New Tenement Application Yanrey Project W.A.

The directors of Scimitar Resources Ltd (Scimitar) (ASX code SIM) are pleased to announce that the Company has applied for an additional Exploration Licence (E08/1658) in the Yanrey Project area. After reviewing radiometric and magnetic images recently released by the GSWA, the Company considers the new application area prospective for roll front Uranium mineralisation.

The new application, situated approximately 50 kilometres south of Bennet Well, is 622 square kilometres bringing the total Yanrey Project area up to 1840 square kilometres. The application covers the basin margin between Palaeoproterozoic rocks of the Gascoyne Complex and the Cretaceous sediments of the Carnarvon Basin.

The Yanrey project is situated 85 kilometres to the south of Onslow and covers Mesozoic sediments that are highly prospective for sandstone hosted roll front uranium mineralisation similar to that at the adjacent Manyingee Uranium Deposit (Paladin Resources Ltd, 100%, ASX code PDN), which has a published indicated and inferred resource of 12,078 tonnes at 0.08% U₃O₈.

Scimitar has a 3000 metre drill program planned for the Bennet Well prospect. This program has been delayed due to heavy rain in the area and drilling is now expected to commence in late April.
